7	BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC 278 BRAMLEY: REQUEST TO CONSIDER A TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984) [Non-Executive function: not available for call-in.]	<b>Resolved</b> that the grounds for making a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) as outlined are met, and a Notice of Intention to make an Order should be published for Byway Open to All Traffic 278 (Bramley) to prevent damage to the road and to preserve and protect the endangered species found therein as shown on Drawing Number 3/1/2/H16 (Annex 1of the report). The results of the consultation and any required repair mitigation will be reported back to a future meeting of the committee for a decision. <b>Reason</b>
		Officers do not have delegated powers to make or advertise TROs. Officers support the decision to make a TRO because it would meet Surrey County Council Policy and would protect the durability of the byway by preventing damage to the road. It would also help us to meet the requirements placed upon us to have regard to the ecology and nature conservation

		of the two protected species found along it.
