

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE CAPITAL PROGRAMME UPDATE

KEY ISSUE

To update the Committee on the progression of previously approved Capital projects, financed through the Committee's devolved Local Transport Plan (LTP) budget or through the delegated Local Allocation.

1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1.1 The Committee have approved LTP and other transportation projects on an on going basis, in accordance with it's delegated authorities. The most recent approvals were given to reports presented to the meeting on 23 March 2005.

2 REPORT

- 2.1 Approved schemes, which have not previously been reported to Committee as COMPLETE are identified in Appendix 'A', with summaries of progress.
- 2.2 There continues to be significant delays between the confirmation of works orders and commencement on site, although work has now been scheduled for most outstanding jobs.
- 2.3 It is of concern that there are significant delays between substantial completion on site and the formal identification and rectification of snagging, which to date has been done by the constructor. No completion certificates have yet been received for any projects, and this has made the Stage 3 Road Safety Audit (RSA3) process very difficult.
- 2.4 The absence of both completion certificates and RSA3 certification (and where necessary exception reports) raises concerns of vulnerability, should accidents occur in the interim period.
- 2.5 Reports will be brought forward to this Committee later in the year to update on budget and expenditure, and to seek any other specific scheme approvals that will be necessary to deliver the LTP and Local Allocation programmes.
- 2.6 Members should note that for most projects Carillion undertake detailed design from Elmbridge Local Transportation Service (LTS) feasibility reports. The procedure is for them to then prepare detailed design drawings, detailed estimate and contractual programme for approval.
- 2.7 For some minor works the LTS prepare detailed drawings and Bills of Quantities and issue construction orders only.

3 CONCLUSION

3.1 The approved LTP and Local Allocation projects are progressing, as set out, and the LTS staff are continuing to work with the constructor to improve process issues.
