

# Tilt Road Waiting Restrictions

## Questionnaire for Residents

Tilt Road is made up of both public highway and common land.

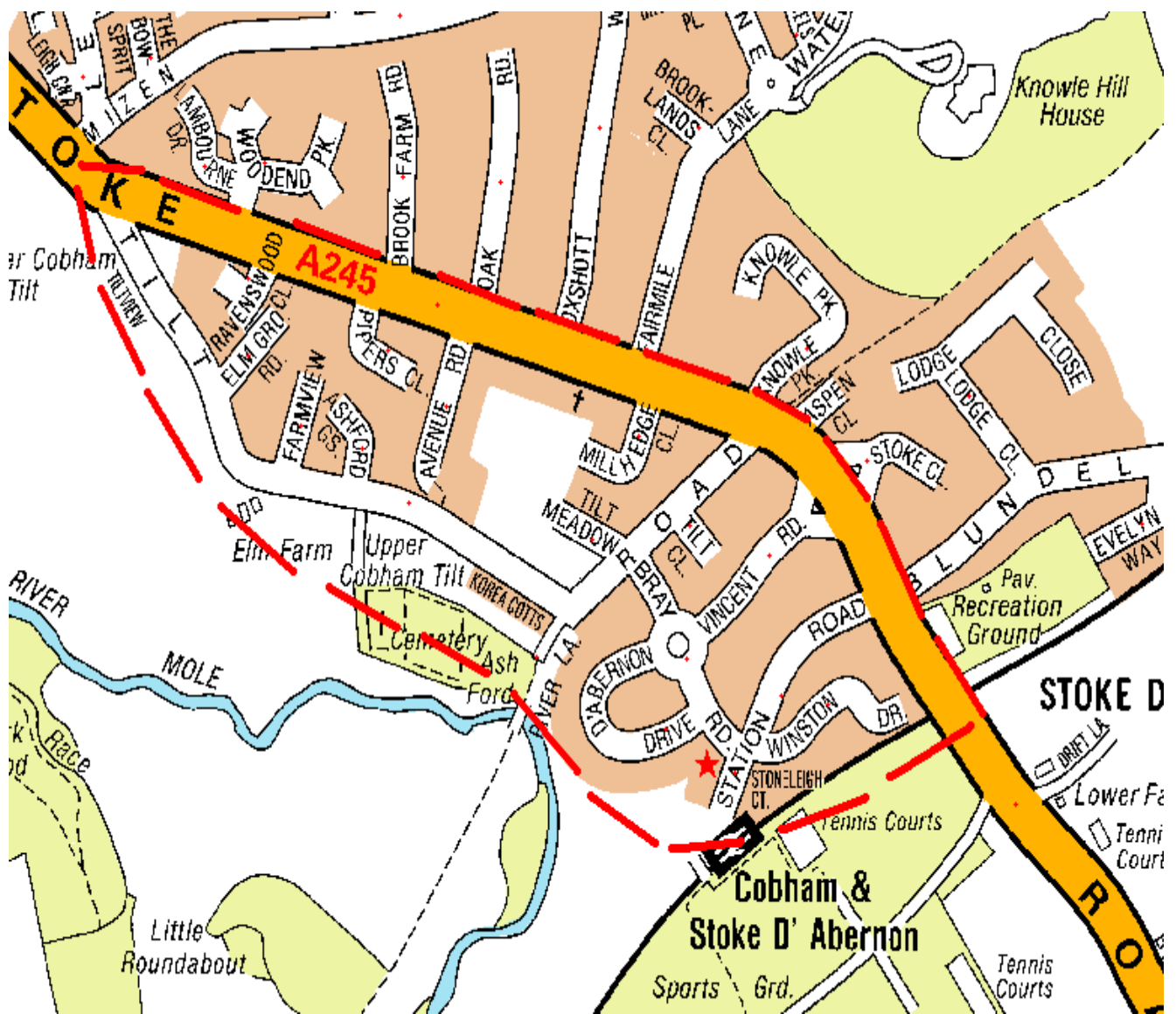
Elmbridge Borough Council, who are responsible for the common land, are concerned that existing parking within Tilt Road constitutes a safety issue and furthermore is detrimental to the street-scene.

Surrey County Council has been asked by Elmbridge Borough Council to facilitate the introduction of waiting restrictions within Tilt Road so that any problem can be addressed as a whole.

However, it is possible that the introduction of waiting restrictions within Tilt Road could displace parking into adjacent roads.

The map below shows the boundary for the initial consultation area. Within this boundary are the roads most likely to be affected by any such scheme.
