1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

1.1 Members are reminded that the following letter of representation was received at the June meeting of this committee:

"We, the undersigned, who are all Shopkeepers/Business owners in and around The Parade, Claygate, are opposed to Surrey County Council's proposed introduction of 'Pay and Display' on-street parking charges on the grounds that it puts at grave risk the viability of our enterprises, and in so doing strikes at the heart of the Claygate Village community. It would replace the current 'one hour free, no return within an hour' system which works well for Traders and shoppers alike".

2 RESPONSE

2.1 The County Council has listened to Surrey residents and businesses across the County and understands the concerns about proposed on street parking charges. As a consequence we have revised our proposals for on street parking charges in many locations, including Claygate where a free 1/2 hour is proposed. A free 30 minutes will help increase turnover of the parking spaces and make sure visitors and residents are not deterred from visiting the local shops. The introduction of pay and display parking charges will enable the council to work more efficiently and provide a better service for residents.
