

## ANNEXE 6

### Runnymede

Runnymede would like to see the tariffs adjusted to distinguish between towns and villages, which was accepted.

Chertsey and Egham were considered to have more robust shopping centres where a free period would not be needed. The town centre car parks charge up to 60p per hour in these locations so a medium tariff of £1.00 would maintain the differential to encourage drivers to use the car parks.

It was suggested that the parking spaces should be split between Station Rd and Station Approach, but the Task Group, decided to leave the designation as proposed, but that the proposed on street charges should be adjusted to accommodate a 30-minute free parking period on a medium tariff in the smaller parade at Virginia Water.

Additional sites were proposed in Addlestone Centre and St Judes Road, Englefield Green, but with a medium tariff and a free 30-minute period, as there is free parking in supermarkets, or on the street in these locations.

Some additional investigation is needed into the status of the market area, which has a Royal Charter giving right for certain activities.

Displacement issues can be tackled during the review period.
