96 residents of Walsingham Gardens	Petitioners are objecting to the proposed 8.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday waiting restrictions on the grounds that they are excessive and will adversely affect residents and visitors.	At the elected members working group held to formally consider all the objections received to various proposals in Epsom, it was agreed the time period would be reduced to 8.30am to 10.30am from Monday to Friday.
30 residents of Elm Road	Petitioners are objecting to the proposed 8.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday waiting restrictions on the grounds that they are excessive and will adversely affect residents and visitors.	At the elected members working group held to formally consider all the objections received to various proposals in Epsom, it was agreed to go ahead with the proposals as they stand with the exception of the section between the eastern boundary of 'The Bungalow' and approximately 10 metres west of Kingston Road. This will be omitted from the order, thereby freeing up space for approximately 8 to 10 cars
20 users of West Hill Road	Petitioners are objecting to the proposed 8.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday waiting restrictions on the grounds that they will adversely affect local businesses (e.g. recruitment / commercial viability).	At the elected members working group held to formally consider all the objections received to various proposals in Epsom, it was agreed the proposals would go ahead as they stand but with a reduced time period of 9:30 to 12:30 Monday to Friday.

27 residents of Woodcote Park Road	Petitioners are objecting to the proposed 8.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday waiting restrictions on the grounds that they will adversely affect residents. The petition claims that the majority of residents do not want restrictions installed.	At the elected members working group held to formally consider all the objections received to various proposals in Epsom, it was agreed that the proposals for Woodcote Park Road would be removed, with the exception of the section on the south side at the junction of Hylands Road
