21/ APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE AND SUBSTITUTIONS [Item 1]

08 Apology for absence was received from Cllr David Wood.

22/ MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING [Item 2]

Minutes of the meeting held on 9 June 2008 were agreed. These were duly signed as a correct record.

28/ SELF RELIANCE PROJECT REPORT [item 8] 08

This project is coming to an end on the 30 September 2008 and the members thanked Keri Marshall, Community Co-ordinator for her hard work and enthusiasm on the project, and wished her well for the future.

The Local Committee was concerned at the lack of funding from Surrey County Council [£130k for 2008/09 across the whole of the county and just £10k for Epsom & Ewell] for building on the existing Self Reliance work that has been very successful. The Chairman agreed to write to the Executive raising the concerns of this Committee.

It was RESOLVED that the Local Committee noted the report

29/ LOCAL NHS HOSPITAL AND OTHER HEALTH SERVICES [item 9] 08

The Local Committee expressed their concerns in regard to mental health services as it was believed that the services were going to be consolidated on to three sites across the county. The EEBC Officer agreed to find out what the implications for Epsom & Ewell were and report back to the members.

The Local Committee expressed their concerns about the length of time the PCT is taking in coming to a decision as regards the proposal from Denbies. The Chairman was asked to write to the Health Scrutiny Committee to express the Local Committee's concerns. The Local Committee agreed to continue to monitor the situation.

It was **RESOLVED** that the Local Committee noted the report.

30/ CONSULTATION ON IMPROVEMENTS TO LEARNING 08 DISABILITY DAY SERVICE [Item 10]

The Local Committee asked the Officers whether the parents and young people have been consulted, and the Officer reported that a wide consultation has taken place and there are currently no concerns. The Members asked to be kept informed of developments for Bentley.

It was **RESOLVED** that this report be noted.

31/ PRIORITY 4 WAITING RESTRICTIONS PHASE 3 [item 11] 08

The Officer advised of the amendments to Annexe 2 and an updated drawing for Wheelers Lane.

The amendment particularly referred to Lyncroft Gardens/Garbrand Walk, Ewell where the waiting restrictions will be progressed as advertised i.e. 11am – 12noon and kept under review.

It was **RESOLVED** that the Local Committee approved the implementation of the third phase of waiting restrictions as detailed in the amended Annexe 2.

32/ INTEGRATED TRANSPORT SCHEME PROGRESS REPORT08 [item12]

It was **RESOLVED** that this report be noted.

USE OF £103,000 FOR ROADS IN EPSOM AND EWELL AND ALLOCATION OF ADDITIONAL £5 MILLION FOR HIGHWAYS [item 13]

The Officer advised that under the proposed use of funding in Epsom & Ewell of the £103,000, the 10k for Stoneleigh Park Road to repair the carriageway subsidence is no longer required to be funded from this budget. The Officer advised that this funding can be applied to the carriageway patching and Cllr Jean Smith requested that Percival Way be a priority over Riverview Road. Members agreed to wait until a cost estimate for the possible work in Percival Way was available before deciding how the £10k should be spent.

It was **RESOLVED** that the Local Committee agreed to approve the use of the £103,000 highways revenue funding for Epsom & Ewell as detailed in item 2.2 of the report. It was noted that the additional funding of £266,309.22 will be allocated as described in paragraphs 2.4 to 2.7 of the report.
