KEY ISSUE

EPSOM AND EWELL CAPITAL PROJECTS PROGRESS

INTEGRATED TRANSPORT SCHEMES		
Project	Progress	
Epsom Town Centre – Accessibility and junction improvements	The Spread Eagle junction continues to be monitored following minor alterations carried out in September in consultation with the Divisional Member. This work has been as a result of perceived red light violations at the pedestrian crossing over High Street on the eastbound approach to the junction.	
	West Street / Station Approach junction improvement – Works to the junction of West Street and Station Approach are substantially complete. There were a number of instances during construction when passers by offered their approval reinforcing the view this will prove to be a worthy improvement. Signal controls at the junction are linked to the Traffic Systems Control Centre and, with earlier amendments to the Spread Eagle signal junction, are expected to deliver journey time improvements for drivers within the town centre.	
	Further opportunities to reduce congestion may be available and Surrey are assisting Epsom and Ewell Borough with the development of Plan E, a major planning strategy for the forthcoming 20 years.	
	Improved pedestrian facilities provided in Hook Rd as part of the major maintenance scheme. A controlled pedestrian route across the left turn slip from Hook Road into East Street is planned for the next financial year, subject to anticipated funding becoming available.	

	South St / Ashley Avenue controlled pedestrian facility Progression of the scheme identified by a feasibility initiative last year will be subject to the outcome of the Plan E consultation and resources becoming available.
Cycle Strategy Scheme	A shared use cycle facility in Station Approach between West Street and Epsom Station was originally to be included in the design of the junction improvement scheme at West Street / Station Approach. Due to the cost of the signal junction, provision of the cycle path will be dependent upon funding from the proposed Epsom Station Redevelopment.
Ruxley Lane alley to Scotts Farm Road	Deed of dedication of land completed. A new head teacher has recently been appointed and a letter has been issued seeking confirmation of their continued support for improvements to the path which incorporate widening over existing school grounds. Works to the path are anticipated next financial year, subject to anticipated funds becoming available
Downs Road Traffic Calming Scheme	Scheme substantially complete and being monitored. Speed surveys conducted post construction show average and 85 th percentile speeds have reduced in all but one location.
B280 – Route Study Christ Church Road Developer funded scheme	Feasibility complete. Maintenance measures identified are to be added to West St/Christ Church Road developer (West Park) funded scheme. Working group meeting held April 2009 and measures identified to be progressed (dates yet to be agreed).
Speed Management – Vehicle Activated Signing to support Police Enforcement	Ruxley Lane safety camera installed. Planned for 2009/10 2 VAS in Church Street, Epsom proposed. 1 VAS in Hook Road 1 VAS in Wells Road 1 VAS in Longdown Lane South 1 VAS in Chessington Road near Derek Avenue Safety camera in Dorking Road subject to funding

General Interchange Improvements and TfL bus stop improvements.	TfL funding for bus stops in Epsom and Ewell unlikely for 2009/10 due to TfL funding limitations. We continue to press TfL for a contribution towards this initiative.
Measures associated with Kiln Lane Link.	Government decision to dedicate funding towards this initiative has been deferred at least until 2016. However, Surrey remain committed to the objectives of the scheme and recognise the potential benefits that may be delivered.
Blenheim Road Recycling Centre	Funding has been identified that may be used to make highway improvements at the entrance to the waste site. At this time it appears unlikely this will include kerb realignment or permanently fixed bollards immediately outside the entrance as these may only be undertaken in tandem with major reconfiguration within the site. However, weekend traffic management arrangements have been operated for the last 18 months and, combined with recently introduced restrictions on those entitled to visit the facility, the potential for conflict between drivers seeking entrance to the site has been significantly reduced.
Stones Road Tunnel	Detailed design being finalised by SCC Bridge Group. Initial works to prepare the site anticipated during 2009/10 with improvements to the tunnel to follow in 2010/11
Waiting Restriction Review	Documents for advertisement of Phase 4 proposals have been viewed by Divisional Members and are to go to press early January. Implementation anticipate February / March 2010. A further list of waiting restriction amendments, termed Phase 5, is the subject of a separate report to this meeting. Phase 5 is planned for implementation during 2010/11.
Watersedge accessibility improvements	Dropped kerbs with tactile paving and parking enhancements - scheme substantially complete. These have included a minor amendment to the bus route through this residential cluster avoiding a difficult turn which had previously been necessary.
Ewell By Pass southbound right turn ban into Cheam Road	Works completed in accordance with original design. Following reports of non compliance, temporary "no right turn" signs have been placed to complement the permanent measures. These too

	are to be made permanent.

Chalk Lane – waiting restrictions and property protection measures	The scheme has been substantially completed and includes alterations to the northern end of the road where non-observance of the no entry restriction was frequently reported. A custom made kerbline bollard has also been ordered for placement on the corner outside number 5 to address a long term problem of turning vehicles making contact with the property.	
Rosebank – parking scheme	Feasibility complete. Consultation with residents complete – scope of works to be shaped to fall within available budget.
