43/ APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE AND SUBSTITUTIONS [item 1]

10 There were no apologies for absence.

44/ MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING [item 2]

10 Minutes of the meeting held on 13 September 2010 were agreed

45/ DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST [item 3]

10 Cllr Frost declared an interest in item 14 [4-7-11 Gang Show] as his wife is a member of the Methodist Church. Cllr Dallen also declared an interest in this item, as he is involved in the show. Cllr Morris declared an interest in item 10, drawing 32, living in Bridge Road.

46/ CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS [Item 4]

10 Cllr Frost advised that following the last meeting of the Local Committee he had written to Network Rail in regard to the Epsom Station development and the closure of the bridge in East Street. He had received a response to advise that both projects will go ahead concurrently, but they will ensure that there is good liaison between the two. Meetings take place regularly between SCC Highway officers and the railway staff.

47/ WRITTEN PUBLIC QUESTION TIME [item 5]

10 Written public questions were received from 2 members of the public. The questions and responses are set out in Annex A.

48/ MEMBERS' QUESTION TIME [item 6]

10 Questions were received from 4 Members. The questions and responses are set out in Annex B.

49/ ADJOURNMENT [item 7]

10 Several members of the public attended, and 10 informal questions were put to the meeting with responses from Officers present or agreement to provide a written response

50/ PETITIONS [item 8]

10 There were 2 petitions received for this meeting. Details of the petitions, and responses from the Officers are set out in Annex C.

51/ BOROUGH PARKING STRATEGY [item 9]

10 Cllr Frost advised that the County parking strategy is likely to be approved in March 2011. The Borough Parking Strategy Task Group have met and are looking at local options, and in view of budget limitations, another meeting of the Task Group will take place to discuss this.

52/ EPSOM & EWELL PARKING REVIEW – PHASE 5 – CONSIDERATION OF FORMAL OBJECTIONS [item 10].

It was RESOLVED that the Local Committee agreed:

[i].the recommendations detailed in Annexe A of the report, with the exception of drawings 23, 30, 32 and 41, where the changes to the Annexe are detailed below:

ii] drawing 23 –agreed that in Marsh Avenue, the single yellow line restriction should be amended to no waiting between 11-12 noon, but to retain the proposed double yellow line restrictions. Proposed by Cllr Mason seconded by Cllr Taylor.

iii] drawing 30 – Dirdene Gardens – That the decision on how to proceed be delegated to the Parking Strategy & Implementation Manager in consultation with the Divisional Member, and the Local Committee Chairman/Vice Chairman. Proposed by Cllr Wood and seconded by Cllr Taylor.

iv] drawing 32 – Bridge Road – agreed for a single yellow line on the side against the railway [north-west side] , with no parking between 10am – 12 noon, and a double yellow line at the corners. Proposed by Cllr Taylor and seconded by Cllr Wood.

v] drawing 41 – High St, Epsom – include wording to proceed ‘subject to the cross-over being achieved within the timeframe.’

vi] that the County Council makes amendments for existing traffic regulation orders and introduces new traffic regulation orders as necessary for the recommended parking controls to be implemented.

vii] the recommended parking controls are implemented.

53/ REVIEW OF STREET FURNITURE – EPSOM TOWN CENTRE [item 11]

10 It was RESOLVED that the Local Committee agreed:

i] To approve the creation of a working group, to choose a style of street furniture for Epsom town Centre.

ii] To agree to finalise the Terms of Reference and membership of the working group at the next Local Committee meeting.
Proposed by Cllr Frost and seconded by Cllr Mason.

- 2.4 Wallace Fields Junior School - £1647 – Cllr Frost
- 2.5 Rosebery School – Alcohol project - £575 – Cllr Frost. Rosebery School are not taking this forward, but Blenheim School are, and Cllr Mason agreed the £575 from her allocation.
