The funding is allocated on locally determined purposes that meet local social, economic or environmental well-being.

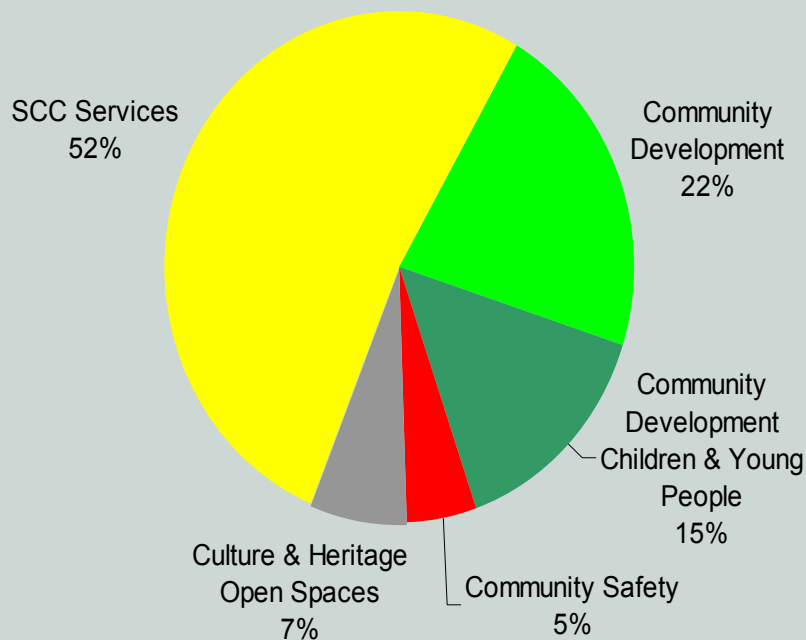

## Members' Allocations 2010/11

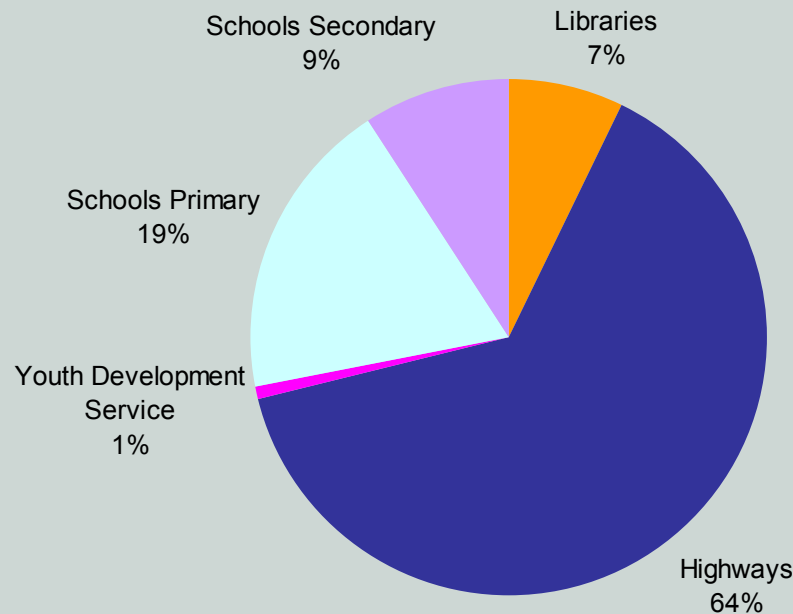
The Committee agreed funding for 57 different projects in 2010/11.

Allocations ranged from £400 to £5,000.

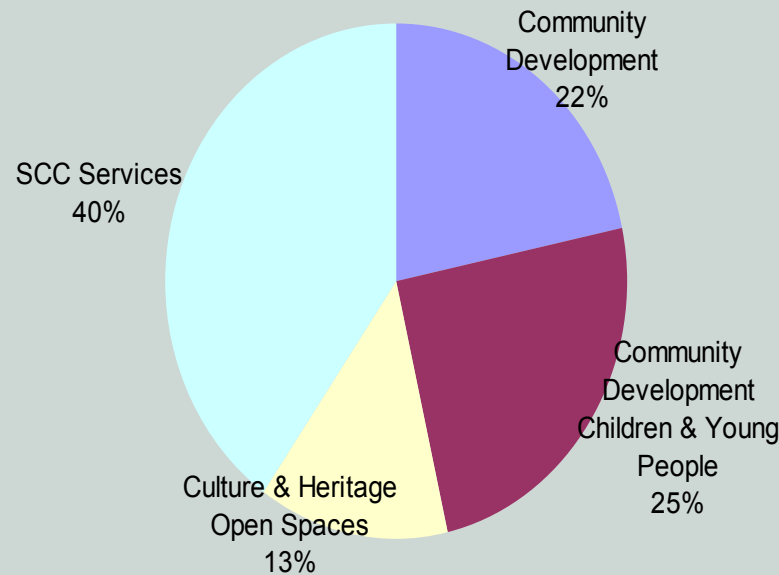
# Revenue Expenditure by Category



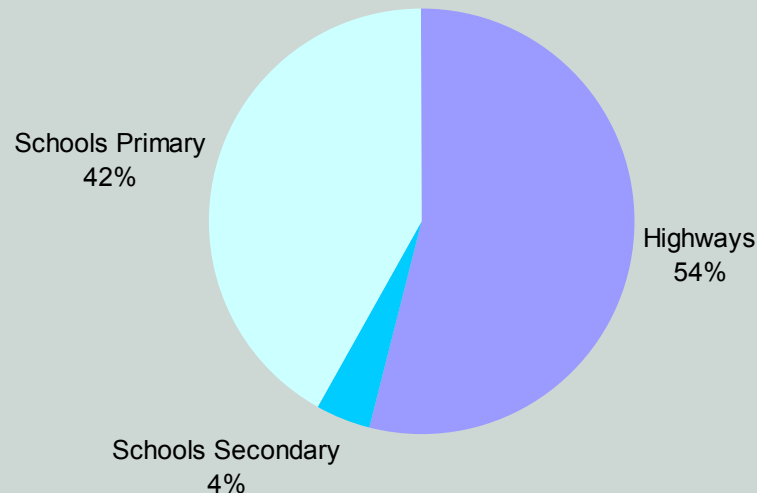
# Breakdown by Service of Revenue Expenditure on SCC services
