This project will allow young people from all backgrounds and with a wide range of abilities and disabilities to participate in activities together in a way that will promote integration that is not normally available to them.

It will also allow the young people to record their accomplishments in a measured way through participation in the Youth Achievement Award scheme at all levels. (Everything from participating in a new activity to leading and organizing an event). This will give them a real sense of achievement and pride as well as providing a record of how the grant has been used.

For those not performing there is the opportunity to be part of the band, get involved in set and costume design, lighting, music and special effects all under the supervision of skilled and willing adult volunteers.	

This gives children and young adults an opportunity to build self confidence through the arts and working as a team.

The show is led by adult volunteers and rehearses from September 2012 until February 2013 when it culminates in a run of public performances.

The end goal is for the children to take part in a publicly ticketed professional quality performance on stage in the Epsom Playhouse, also within the local community.

We believe that offering a really professional quality show in all aspects give the children a much greater experience and includes a higher level of learning in respect of both the art of performance and the trade of the theatre. Something that will help them in future life.

This grant will enable us to ensure we are able to offer all of this without compromise of venue and quality of production at a time when normal fund raising activity is constrained.

- An interactive programme enaging the groups in age appropriate activities under the following headings:
 - Communication skills
 - Safeguarding issues
 - Team Building exercises
 - Leadership scenarioes
 - Planning and preparation skills
 - Cretative and Sports activities
 - Empowerment opportunities
- *Follow up of young people in local settings to support them in delivering/using the skills learnt at the weekend.
- *On going opprotunities for the young people of 14+ years to serve as volunteers in their local units

Outcomes:

- To integrate members from 6 different local groups who would not normally mix together- encompassing a range of socioecomomic groups, different cultures and different nationalities
- To train them in the development of leadership skills
- To empower them to help lead others in their local units
