PARKING FOR RESIDENTS IN THE FUTURE

The number of residents who apply for permits and the number of households with 2 permits is growing each year. There is only a limited amount of parking space available on the street. The price of a permit has not changed since 1997. The money from permit charges pays for the administration of the scheme. If the numbers continue to grow what would you like us to do?

Do nothing and let people compete for space	
Limit the number of permits issued for new residents to one per household	
Set a limit on the number of permits issued and introduce a waiting list for new applicants	
Increase the cost of permits, particularly for a second permit, to deter second vehicles	
Increase the cost of a permit and fund more rigorous checks on eligibility, for example checking eligibility each year	
Strengthen the proof applicants need to provide to show they are resident to make it harder for non-residents to get permits	
Restrict the number of daily permits	
Reduce the waiting period to 1 hour (in Areas A,B,C & E)	
Increase the charge for daily permits to discourage use
