1. NAME OF MEMBER(S): Cllr Fiona White

2. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT TO BE FUNDED:

£2100 contribution to fund the after-school use of the Astroturf facilities at Kings College School over the next 12 months, for football or other activity. SCC's Youth Development Service already runs 1 football club each week; this project aims to increase the sessions to up to 5 sessions per week.

- 3. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS FUNDING? To provide positive and healthy activities for pupils, ex-pupils and others and prevent anti-social behaviour taking place around the school at the end of the school day.
- 4. WHAT IS IT EXPECTED TO ACHIEVE? BY WHEN? A decrease in antisocial behaviour over the 12-month period. The school will monitor the levels of anti-social behaviour. Students from nearby Surrey University and members of local football clubs will be asked to help run the sessions.
- 5. WHO HAS BEEN CONSULTED ABOUT THIS PROPOSAL? Kings College School, SCC Youth Development Service, Surrey Police, Safer Guildford Partnership, SCC Education Service, Barn Youth Project, Healthy Living Programme

6. FINANCIAL DETAILS OF THE FUNDING:

- (i) What is the total cost of the project? Up to £8,400 to provide up to 4 extra sessions per week
- (ii) **How much is this funding proposal?** £2,100 for one extra session per week
- (iii) When is the funding required? Asap
- (iv) Are there any financial implications beyond the current year? Not for the Committee; funding after the 12-month period is being sought.
- (v) What funding has been obtained from other sources?£2,000 from the Safer Guildford Partnership.
