- The Highway Maintenance event will be at SCC Office in Cross Lanes, Guildford on Thursday 8th March 2007 at 7pm.
- 6 Members are invited to propose ideas for the agenda or programme of the remaining two engagement events and the expected outcomes of each of the meetings.
