

Organisation responsible for carrying out the project?	The Matrix Trust, based in Guildford, works cooperatively and creatively in the community and seeks to connect churches, projects and youth workers with a particular focus on youth and emerging cultures.
Description of Project: What outcomes are expected? What needs will it address? What geographical area will it cover? Who will benefit? How many people?	The trust has a Schools Relational worker in the school full time, who is part of the pastoral team. Due to limited space in the school the worker does not have a dedicated area to work in. The funding is required to build/convert a suitable space. This would enable the youth workers to provide a more effective youth work programme in the school, including workshops, drop- in sessions at break, lunchtime & after school as well as private counselling. More students would be able to receive the service and students struggling with similar issues could work through them in groups. The needs that will be addressed include self-esteem issues, self harming, interpersonal skills, relationships skills & helping young people build good solid relationships with adults.
