KEY ISSUE

Highway maintenance is an important function of the County Council, which impacts on all Surrey residents. To maximise the benefit from available funding, a sound asset management approach is being adopted. Historically highway works have been a combination of planned and reactive work. The intention is that with good management the amount of reactive work can be decreased.
