

# LOCAL COMMITTEE CAPITAL & REVENUE SPENDING UPDATE 2008/9

## SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL LOCAL COMMITTEE (GUILDFORD)

9 December 2009

#### **Key Issue:**

This report provides an updated review of the ways in which the Local Committee's Revenue & Capital allocation for 2008/9 was spent.

#### **Summary:**

As part of the development of Local Committees, in 2008/09 the County Council provided revenue funds of £11,000 per Member and capital funds of £35,000 per committee to support voluntary or community groups. This report shows how projects have progressed towards achieving outcomes to enhance the 'social, economic and environmental well-being' of Guildford residents.


- i) to note this review of the Capital & Revenue allocations for 2008/09
- ii) to comment on progress made and any concerns about delayed projects.
- iii) to decide on any changes to the way the Committee deploys any future funding e.g. by pooling funds or agreeing strategic themes for the funding.

#### 1 REVIEW OF 2008/9 REVENUE ALLOCATIONS

- 1.1 For 2008/9, Surrey County Council allocated revenue funds of £11,000 per Member to be spent in ways that enhance the "economic, environmental or social well-being of the community". Members propose the use of the funds but the Committee can decide, for example:
  - That each Member spends their allocation on projects wholly within their division
  - That the whole sum be spent on one or two projects agreed by the Committee as a whole to be prioritised, or
  - That an agreed part of the total funding is allocated to individual projects within divisions and the remainder spent on a project agreed to be of priority to the Committee.

Annex 1 shows the progress made in each of these projects.

- 1.2 In practice, Members have mainly chosen to spend their allocation wholly within their own division. There are a couple of examples where Members have combined funds to ensure greater impact with fairly small sums of money. Five Members contributed towards the trip to Malawi for Looked after Children at Libertas and six Members along with Members of other SCC local committees pooled funds to assist with the production of new films for the Surrey Fire & Rescue Service's Safe Drive Stay Alive campaign. In the main, Members have taken the lead in developing proposals for funding projects, although they have also considered ideas put forward by officers from individual services and organisations.
- 1.3 100% of the funds for 2008/09 were allocated by the 31 March 2009. Annex 1 shows the progress achieved by individual projects or, where Members' funds have contributed to fund-raising for larger schemes, identifiable steps and timescales on the way to delivering outcomes. This is part of the tracking to monitor that projects use the funds appropriately and the original objectives are being met.
- 1.4 The amount allocated to projects in 2008/09 was £123,172. Although each of the ten Members received £11,000 the total spent exceeds this amount due to some funding being returned from previous years for various reasons. Each of the projects is categorised to assist with monitoring. As shown in the graph below the largest category to receive funding was Highways (29%, £36,095) followed by Young People (22%, £26,682) and then Self Reliance (17%, £20,369).
- 1.5 Most of the other strategic priorities or services of the County Council have been supported, to different degrees. However it should be noted that many projects could in reality be recorded under more than one category.



#### 2 REVIEW OF 2008/9 CAPITAL ALLOCATIONS

2.1 At the committee meeting held on 18<sup>th</sup> June 2008 Members agreed that a theme of older and vulnerable people, and carers be applied to the Capital allocation for the capital funding in 2008/9. Bids were invited from voluntary and community groups providing services to older or vulnerable adults and/or their carers in the Guildford borough area. The decisions on which projects to fund were taken at the local committee meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

Annexe 2 shows the progress made in each of these projects.

#### 3 UPDATE ON PROJECTS FROM PREVIOUS YEARS

3.1 Projects funded by members' allocations in previous years, which were not complete at the time of the last annual update in December 2008 continue to be monitored and updates requested as appropriate. Further information can be requested from the Guildford Local Partnerships Team.
