A public meeting, held on 29th April by objectors to Phase 2 of the Leatherhead High Street environmental enhancement project, has led to a request that the contract be cancelled and works halted. Objections are based in part on the desire introduce a road link from Church Street to North Street. | Attachment:

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The report outlines the history of consultations and decisions that led to the dropping of a vehicular link between Church Street and North Street from the Mole Valley Local Plan and the Local Transport Plan. It also considers the measures taken to consult on the design proposals for Phase 2 and the response to the consultation.

The report concludes that the issues surrounding Phase 2 were debated at length and over a number of years. The introduction of a vehicular link between Church Street and North Street would be contrary to policies contained within the Local Transport Plan for Surrey and policies accepted by the Government Office as the basis of funding local programmes. The report also concludes that prior to letting the contract for the works both councils took into account that the majority of those who expressed views on the proposals supported it.

The recommendation to the committee is that work should proceed.
