



OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (MOLE VALLEY)

LEATHERHEAD WAITING RESTRICTION REVIEW UPDATE 26 SEPTEMBER 2007

KEY ISSUE

To update the Committee about the Leatherhead waiting restriction review.

SUMMARY

Leatherhead Councillors (County and District) met on the 19 June to review requests for new or amended waiting and parking restrictions in Leatherhead. A number of proposals were discussed that could be taken forward for either further investigation or initial consultation with residents.

Some of the requests were for the provision of residents parking permits. This would require the introduction of a Controlled Parking Zone(s), which is a possibility in the future if the current CPZ proposals in Dorking are considered a success. It is however unlikely that a Leatherhead CPZ would be economically viable on its own without a Dorking CPZ.

Parking questionnaire's have subsequently been delivered to residents of 5 roads in order determine their views about new waiting and parking restrictions. These are Dilston Road, Kingston Avenue, Oaks Close, Park Rise and Randalls Road. The return date for the Questionnaire's was the 7th September and a further meeting has been arranged with local members to discuss the results and the best way forward.

In addition waiting restrictions have been investigated in other locations in Leatherhead including Epsom Road for discussion at this meeting.

It is likely that a report will be submitted to the Local Committee in December.
