EPSOM ROAD, LEATHERHEAD - PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE FACILITY

In June 2009, Surrey County Council agreed to improve pedestrian and cycle links between Leatherhead Road and Leatherhead Town Centre. As a result, the pavement on the northern side of Epsom Road was resurfaced and segregated pedestrian and cycle lanes were marked out between the Knoll Roundabout and St John's School. However there were problems with the work and after a short time, the decision was taken to remove the segregated lanes.

Surrey County Council is considering whether to reinstate a segregated pedestrian and cycle path on this northern pavement; to leave it as it is, with the full width of the footway being shared by pedestrians and cyclists or possibly to mark out a cycle lane on the carriageway of Epsom Road itself. An alternative, parallel cycle route also exists a short distance away along Linden Pit Path/St John's Close.

In order to make an informed decision, the Council is asking for the views of all interested parties, including users of the pavement and cycleway, residents in the vicinity and local schools and businesses. The intention is to report the results of this consultation to the Surrey County Council Local Committee on 22 June 2011. However, if additional work needs to be done to the road or pavement, this will need the Council's approval.
