# HIGHWAYS SCHEMES PROGRESS REPORT

## **O8 JUNE 2011**

## **KEY ISSUE**

To update the Local Committee on the progress of Integrated Transport and maintenance schemes on the highways in Mole Valley district.

### **SUMMARY**

At the 3 March 2011 Local Committee agreed a programme of work for highways in Mole Valley. The majority of the maintenance schemes are now programmed and works have commenced. Work has commenced on the investigation and design of the Integrated Transport schemes, with priority being given to the three speed management schemes that have previous Committee approval. This report sets out recent progress.
