

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (MOLE VALLEY)

HIGHWAYS SCHEMES 2011/12 – END OF YEAR UPDATE 7th MARCH 2012

KEY ISSUE

To inform the Local Committee on the outcome of the 2011/12 Integrated Transport and highways maintenance schemes programmes in Mole Valley.

SUMMARY

At the 3rd March 2011 Local Committee, Members agreed a programme of work for highways in Mole Valley. This report sets out the outcomes of both the Integrated Transport Schemes programme and the programme of maintenance works.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Committee is asked to note the report for information.

1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In March 2011, Mole Valley Local Committee agreed a programme of capital Integrated Transport Schemes (ITS) and revenue Maintenance expenditure for 2011/12 in Mole Valley. The capital budget for ITS schemes was £184,333 and the revenue maintenance budget was £100,000. In addition to this, each County Member was allocated £5,000 Community Pride funding to spend on improvements in their local area. The budgets for the above programmes were devolved to the Local Committee.
- 1.2 In addition, there are capital budgets that are delegated to the Head of Surrey Highways for highways works across the County. These budgets cover major maintenance, surface treatments, footway schemes and flooding and drainage schemes.
- 1.3 Developer contributions and other external sources provide a further area of funding of highway improvement schemes.

2 ANALYSIS

- 2.1 **Annex 1** sets out the 2011/12 approved programme of works in Mole Valley under the headings described above and provides an update on progress to date.
- 2.2 It is suggested that those ITS schemes which were design only this year or are on-going should be carried forward onto the ITS programme for 2012/13. The 2012/13 programme is the subject of a separate report to this meeting of the Mole Valley Local Committee.
- 2.3 Table 1 below shows the revenue maintenance allocations for 2011/12, together with progress to date. This budget will have been spent in full by the end of the financial year.

- 2.4 Mole Valley Local Committee was allocated £30,000 Community Pride Fund, which equates to £5,000 per County Member, to pay for small highway improvements to benefit the local community. This budget is projected to be spent in full by the end of the financial year.
- 2.5 Two major maintenance schemes have been delivered in Mole Valley this financial year and an extensive programme of surface treatment schemes has been substantially completed. Unfortunately, due to weather constraints, the micro asphalt programme in Mole Valley has been deferred to 2012/13 and will be given priority for early implementation.
- 2.6 In addition, Local Structural Repair schemes have been carried out at the following locations, funded from the central highways budget.

Leatherhead Road, Ashtead West Farm Avenue, Ashtead Coldharbour Lane, Dorking Mole Street, Ockley Sole Farm Road, Bookham Ridgeway Drive, Dorking Sheephouse Green, Wotton Headley Road, Leatherhead

2.7 Two externally funded schemes have been delivered this financial year. The Ministry of Defence has funded the implementation of zebra crossing in Headley Road by Headley Court. Section 106 developer funding was used to finance the realignment of the traffic signals at the junction of the A25 Reigate Road/Old London Road in Dorking.

3 FINANCIAL AND VALUE FOR MONEY IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The key objective with regard to the 2011/12 budgets has been to manage to a neutral position.

4 EQUALITIES AND DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The Highway Service is mindful of its needs within this area and attempts to treat all users of the public highway with equality and understanding.

5 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

5.1 A well managed highway network can reduce fear of crime and allow the Police greater opportunity to enforce speed controls.

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6 CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1 This report sets out the highway works carried out in Mole Valley in 2011/12, for Members information.
