The objective is to provide a Christmas activity for those who would otherwise not have a Christmas event to attend and at a time of year when those who are isolated often find this fact highlighted. The Christmas parties are also used as a way to introduce people to the Friends Groups. These are groups that meet on a regular basis to provide both companionship and activities to older people who otherwise might feel isolated. These groups have been running for around 2 years. The Christmas party is used to provide entertainment and companionship but are also attended by service providers, giving them a chance to talk to service users. This allows residents to be informed of services that could help them and they may not be accessing but also provides services with feedback regarding their services. Examples services are police, fire and telecare.</p>
