HORLEY GARDENS ESTATE RESIDENTS PARKING ZONE PROGRESS UPDATE

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL'S LOCAL COMMITTEE (REIGATE AND BANSTEAD)

24TH JULY 2006

A letter drop was made to all residents within the proposed scheme in late June consisting of the following:

- Information about the proposed restrictions and how to seek further information.
- Information about the proposed programme and when enforcement would start (It was stated that the works would start during the first week in July and would last for about 6 weeks)
- Application forms for parking permits with guidance notes.

The road marking and signing works began on programme on Monday 3rd July. The road marking works have now been substantially completed and the signing works should be substantially completed by the end of July.

Several abandoned/untaxed vehicles have been identified and are in the process of being removed. Is planned to start enforcement of the restriction in late August. It has been possible to make very minor alterations to the locations of parking bays and waiting restrictions etc in order to accommodate most residents.

There have been a large number of enquires to the East Area Highways Office, the Reigate and Banstead Parking Office and the Horley Helpshop about the scheme by local residents. These have often been to seek clarification of the proposals. The Reigate and Banstead Parking team are processing permit application forms in order to meet the enforcement deadline of late August.
