Decriminalised Parking Enforcement Review & Residents Parking Zones Funded through Local Allocation in 2005/06 and Local Transport Plan in 2006/07	 Horley Gardens Estate complete. Enforcement started 1st September 2006 – interim review undertaken. Further review to take place after summer 2007. Northern Villages Decriminalised Parking Enforcement review – proposals agreed at Local Committee on 24th July 2006. Schedules and advertising complete, objections discussed and resolved with Members implementation planned for May/June 2007. North West Reigate Residents Parking Zone – consultation completed and responses analysed and discussion held with Divisional Member – further study work required to identify/address displaced parking.

A23 Corridor (Hooley to Horley) Measures to support the Redhill Quality Bus Partnership and Fastway and safety measures within the corridor.	Planting completed at junction of A23 and Woodhatch Road to improve safety by screening forward view. Next phase of scheme to be reviewed and progressed and co-ordinated with joint Surrey County

Feasibility design complete, Stage 1 Road Safety Audit undertaken and detailed design order issued to Carillion. Implementation planned for 2007/08 dependent upon available funding and Local Committee approval.

MHIS 9/267 Croydon Road/Wray Lane/Batts Hill crossing MHIS 9/222 A242 Gatton Park Road – possible Section 106	Detailed design and consultation with emergency services completed. As a result amended design produced and approved at 5 March 2007 Local Committee. Detailed design ongoing.
Safe Route To School - A217 Woodhatch crossroads junction – including pedestrian phases on the Prices Lane and Woodhatch Arms of the junction	Scheme to be undertaken in two phases to overcome the problems of common land acquisition. Orders have been sent to utility companies to carry out diversionary works, which has resulted in some delay to the main scheme. Improvements work now programmed to commence in May/June 2007 as a result of new requirements to meet the revised Construction Design and Management Health and Safety Regulations that recently came into force.
Balcombe Road / Station Road traffic signal improvement (linked with maintenance and Reigate and Banstead Borough Council scheme)	Scheme complete, including Reigate and Banstead Borough Council enhancement works.
MHIS 9/237 Great Tattenhams - pedestrian islands and roundabout	Design produced, discussed with Divisional Member and approved at 5 th March Local Committee. Detailed design order placed with Carillion.
MHIS 9/233 Waterhouse Lane/Outwood Lane speed management	Review of potential proposals underway. Feasibility plan/report being developed which will include proposals to enhance crossing facilities to Chipstead Valley school (a source of funding any resulting scheme has yet to be identified).
Mini Roundabout at Outwood Lane/Lower Park Road	Stage 3 safety audit completed. Supplementary works to be undertaken.

A217 Route Study - Borough Boundary to M25 (to address MHIS 9/243 speed issues, crossing issues and MHIS 9/270 Buckland Road/Smithy Lane junction) Funded through Local Allocation in 2005/06 and Local Transport Plan in 2006/07	Feasibility drawings in progress. Proposals have been developed for the Burgh Wood junction, which have been discussed with local County and Borough Members and the Police. At this meeting concerns were raised by the Police regarding the lack of a traffic signal controlled right turn from Fir Tree Road at Banstead crossroads and that this should be addressed before undertaking any works to restrict the right turn out of Burgh Wood. As a result a trial scheme has been undertaken which has been monitored and amended in stages. Public meeting held with Lower Kingswood residents Association and many issues raised that can be investigated by feasibility study. This consultation has assisted in developing a series of short, medium and long-term measures. These will be linked in with Reigate and Banstead Borough Council's Local Community Action Plan work in this area.		
Safe Route To School - Prices Lane/Sandcross Lane/Slipshatch Road junction, pedestrian safety study, Reigate	Pedestrian improvement within the headway of Sandcross Lane complete. A controlled crossing over Prices Lane is proposed and will be funded by developer subject to the Section 278 Agreement, which has yet to be signed.		
MHIS 9/244 Borough Cycling Strategy	Proposals have been drawn up in association with Reigate and Banstead Borough Council to undertake the further development of the Redhill to Reigate cycle route. These will dovetail with recently completed facilities at Croydon Road and include Madeira Walk, Doods Road/Wray Common Road and A25 station Road.		
Bus stop accessibility and public transport improvements	Review of next priorities to be undertaken. Improvements to bus stop/bay markings to be undertaken. Surrey County Council's Passenger Transport group are currently assessing the likely demand for a formal bus hardstanding at Canada Drive/east surrey Hospital.		
Disabled Access and pedestrian schemes	Previously undertaken Town Centre Accessibility Studies are to be reviewed and future schemes identified. Current works include relocation of street furniture where these cause obstructions for the mobility impaired.		
Transport Hub Development and development of Company/Business Travel Plans	Assessment of implications of transport hub being developed and a scoping report produced which has been discussed with Reigate and Banstead Borough Council and co-ordinated with joint Surrey County Council/Reigate and Banstead Borough Council New Growth Points project.

Discussions held with Reigate and Banstead Borough Council officers regarding short term improvements to the bus station who are to undertake the required improvement works. Medium terms works planned under New Growth Points project.	
Development of Safe Routes to Schools	This strategy is being developed in consultation with the Surrey County Council's Safer Smarter Travel Team and future measures have been identified. And are currently being prioritised. Feasibility ongoing on measures in Gatton Park Road and Alma Lane.
