LOCAL COMMUNITY ACTION PLAN TADWORTH VILLAGE

7 DECEMBER 2009

KEY ISSUE

Reigate and Banstead Borough Council have a rolling programme for developing Local Community Action Plans across the Borough. The plans are informed by residents and local stakeholders following extensive consultation at a community level.

The process is intended to support Members in their representational and community leadership roles and Reigate and Banstead Borough Council use the plans to inform their budget and service planning and priority setting.

As some of the issues that are raised within the plans are the responsibility of other organisations including the County Council, the process has been further developed to involve County Council Members and Officers. Part of this process is an opportunity for the Local Committee to comment on the draft Local Community Action Plans as they are developed.
