Funding is sought to provide and improved Christmas celebration for Age Concern members in Merstham, Redhill, Reigate and Meadvale (approximately 140 people in total) by the addition of a glass of wine, crackers, after dinner mints, a small gift each and subsidy for the cost of the three course meal, plus some live entertainment with audience participation and some hamper raffles. The majority of members live alone or have relatives living abroad or far away. By providing a special Christmas party with all the additional entertainment and making it a real party it is probably the only "family style" Christmas most of them will have. The total cost of providing the celebration is £644.50, with the remainder of the cost being met by raffle money and the organisation's own resources.

2. CONCLUSION AND REVISED RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Surrey County Council Local Committees receive delegated funding to allocate on locally determined purposes that meet local social, economic or environmental well-being.
