## 1. ADDITIONAL REVENUE BID

1.1 The following is a new funding proposal from Local Committee **revenue** funding:

WHITEBUSHES YOUTH CLUB

Members Mrs Frances King

Amount Proposed £2,000

**Summary of Proposal** 

Funding is sought to contribute to the setting up of a youth club in Whitebushes as the local Police Safer Neighbourhoods Team (SNT) have identified that there are a lot of young people on the estate who would benefit from a youth club within their locality. The SNT has successfully set up a youth club in Salfords and would like to do the same for Whitebushes residents. The aim of the project is to reduce anti-social behaviour and increase community spirit. It will also give young people on the estate a place to go once a week and stop them saying that they have "nothing to do". The proposed location for the youth club will be Whitebushes Village Hall. The funding will be used for the purchase of equipment such as bean bags, a games console and games, pool table, outdoor equipment and tuck shop stock, although there will be consultation with the young people to find out what they would like to be included.

## 2. CONCLUSION AND REVISED RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Surrey County Council Local Committees receive delegated funding to allocate on locally determined purposes that meet local social, economic or environmental well-being.
