

## OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (REIGATE AND BANSTEAD)

# HIGHWAYS SCHEMES 2011/12 – END OF YEAR UPDATE 5 MARCH 2012

#### **KEY ISSUE**

To inform the Local Committee on the outcome of the 2011/12 Integrated Transport and highways maintenance schemes programmes in Reigate and Banstead.

#### **SUMMARY**

At the 28 February 2011 Local Committee, Members agreed a programme of work for highways in Reigate and Banstead. This report sets out the outcomes of both the Integrated Transport Schemes programme and the programme of maintenance works.

#### OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Committee is asked to note the report for information.

#### 1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In February 2011, Reigate and Banstead Local Committee agreed a programme of capital Integrated Transport Schemes (ITS) and revenue Maintenance expenditure for 2011/12 in Reigate and Banstead. The capital budget for ITS schemes was £223,050 and the revenue maintenance budget was £100,000. In addition to this, each County Member was allocated £5,000 Community Pride funding to spend on improvements in their local area. The budgets for the above programmes were devolved to the Local Committee.
- 1.2 In addition, there are capital budgets that are delegated to the Head of Surrey Highways for highways works across the County. These budgets cover major maintenance, surface treatments, footway schemes and flooding and drainage schemes.
- 1.3 Developer contributions and other external sources provide a further area of funding of highway improvement schemes.

#### 2 ANALYSIS

- 2.1 Annex 1 sets out the 2011/12 approved programme of works in Reigate and Banstead under the headings described above and provides an update on progress to date.
- 2.2 It should be noted that in 2011/12, Members allocated nearly 75% of Reigate and Banstead's Integrated Transport Schemes budget to Local Structural Repair (LSR) schemes. Using this budget, the Local Committee has funded LSR schemes at the following locations.

Headley Drive, Tadworth Sandlands Road, Walton on the Hill Wonford Close, Walton on the Hill Canons Lane, Burgh Heath Heath Close, Banstead Tadworth Street, Tadworth

This has enabled roads that were not prioritised through any other process to be repaired and has been appreciated by the residents who live there. This is double the number of roads treated in 2010/11.

2.3 In addition, LSR schemes have been carried out at the following locations, funded from the central highways budget.

Hazelwood Lane, Chipstead
Batts Hill, Redhill
Yewlands Close, Banstead
Mellow Close, Banstead
Yew Tree Bottom Road, Epsom Downs
Watermead, Tadworth
Albert Road, Horley

- 2.4 It is suggested that those ITS schemes which were design only this year or are on-going should be carried forward onto the ITS programme for 2012/13. The 2012/13 programme is the subject of a separate report to this meeting of the Reigate and Banstead Local Committee.
- 2.5 Table 1 below shows the revenue maintenance allocations for 2011/12, together with progress to date. This budget will have been spent in full by the end of the financial year.

- 2.6 Reigate and Banstead Local Committee was allocated £45,000 Community Pride Fund, which equates to £5,000 per County Member, to pay for small highway improvements to benefit the local community. This budget has been spent in full to carry out works such as minor footway repairs, carriageway patching, provision of bollards and fencing works.
- 2.7 Five major maintenance schemes will be delivered in Reigate and Banstead by the end of the financial year and an extensive programme of surface treatment schemes has been substantially completed. Unfortunately, due to weather constraints, the micro asphalt programme in Reigate and Banstead has been deferred to 2012/13 and will be given priority for early implementation.

2.8 Two externally funded schemes have been delivered this financial year. The Royal Albert and Alexandra School in Redhill has funded the implementation of a toucan crossing in Gatton Park Road, with additional funding being allocated by the Borough Council from s106 monies. The delivery of this scheme was an excellent example of working with an external organisation and the Borough Council. The existing pedestrian crossing on Queensway, Redhill was upgraded using s106 developer funding.

#### 3 FINANCIAL AND VALUE FOR MONEY IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The key objective with regard to the 2011/12 budgets has been to manage to a neutral position.

#### 4 EQUALITIES AND DIVERSITY IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The Highway Service is mindful of its needs within this area and attempts to treat all users of the public highway with equality and understanding.

#### 5 CRIME AND DISORDER IMPLICATIONS

5.1 A well managed highway network can reduce fear of crime and allow the Police greater opportunity to enforce speed controls.

#### 6 CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

6.1 This report sets out the highway works carried out in Reigate and Banstead in 2011/12, for Members information.
