LOCAL ALLOCATION 2005/06

12 December 2005

KEY ISSUE:

To agree the final quarter of this year's projects funded from the Local Allocation for 2005/06

SUMMARY:

To appraise Members of the current situation regarding the programme.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Committee is asked to agree:

- (i) the final quarter programme; and
- (ii) suggest any further scheme for the balance of the allocation.

1. INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Leader of the County Council, in his budget speech, announced that the Local Allocation would be £100,000 for 2005/06 for each of the 11 Local Offices.
- 1.2 It is has been agreed that, as in previous years, any under or overspends on this budget will roll forward to the next financial year. As previously reported the final outturn for 2004/05 showed an overspend of £6,953 thereby reducing the available budget for 2005/06 to £93,048.
- 1.3 As Members will recall agreement was made at their Local Committee Meeting 10 October to delegate authority to the Chair, the Vice-Chair, the Area Transportation Director and the Local Transportation Manager to agree expenditure of the Local Allocation.

2. ANALYSIS & COMMENTARY

- 2.1 The following Projects \ Schemes have been agreed by Members. A brief update is given with each
- 2.2 £10000 to provide cycle facilities

Sites located and order issued

2.3 £10000 to grass verge signing

No action to date

2.4 £6000 to the feasibility of the B375 Chertsey Bridge Road to Ferry Lane cycle facility study. This study will investigate the viability of providing a range of cycle facilities along a route that connects Chertsey to Shepperton.

A preliminairy design has been prepared and consultation will be carried out in December and reported to Committee in February.

2.5 £10,000 to the provision of low cost bus stop infrastructure improvements, such as mobility ramps.

Sites identified and design & construction order (subject to estimated cost) to be issued in December.

2.6 £5,000 to the feasibility of providing a pedestrian footbridge, across the railway line on B3003 Clockhouse Lane in association with London Borough of Hounslow.

Discussion ongoing with LBH.

2.7 £10,000 to support the ongoing programme of safety posters and vehicle activated signs across the Borough.

Programme ongoing.

2.8 £5,000 to cover additional works in Long Lane, Stanwell for enhancements to the width restriction.

No action to date.

2.9 £1,000 to the feasibility of traffic calming in New Park Road, Ashford.

Feasibility complete. No action to be taken

2.10 £1,000 to the feasibility of traffic calming in Park Road, Ashford.

Feasibility complete. No action to be taken.

2.11 £10,000 to support the development of traffic management in Manor Farm Avenue, Shepperton.

Consultation complete. See Item 13

2.11 Additional project (subject to Members agreement see item 12) £10000 to purchase additional variable message signs together with provision for facilities to locate them in Manor Lane, Sunbury.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 Current cost projection totals £80,500 from an allocation of £93,048 leaving £12,548 remaining.
