

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (SPELTHORNE)

A308 STAINES ROAD WEST/ SCHOOL ROAD, ASHFORD PETITION

08 OCTOBER 2007

KEY ISSUE & SUMMARY

To advise the Committee that a petition has been received from Mr J Ward signed by 357 residents requesting that a right turn filter arrow is introduced on the School Road approach to the junction with the A308 Staines Road West and that the BP garage entry/exit at the southern end of School Road is closed.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Committee (Spelthorne) is asked to agree that:

- (i) the petition is noted;
- (ii) a feasibility study is undertaken to consider the introduction of a right turn filter arrow and the closure of the BP garage entry/exit on School Road at its junction with the A308 Staines Road West, Ashford. This would be carried out in conjunction with the Safe Routes to School proposal to provide a pedestrian crossing facility across the A308 Staines Road West as identified in Annex D of the Local Transportation Programme Review report included elsewhere on this agenda; and
- (iii) the lead petitioner is advised of the decision of this Committee.
