

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (SPELTHORNE)

PETITION AGAINST PROPOSED "CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE" FOR STAINES

10 DECEMBER 2007

KEY ISSUE

To advise the Committee that a petition has been received from Mr Robert Owsianka, signed by 177 residents from Gresham Road, Richmond Road, Augur Close, Edgell Road, Langley Road, Budebury Road and Beehive Road against a "Controlled Parking Zone" for Staines. The petition states that the signatories are firmly opposed to the proposed "Controlled Parking Zone" in their area of Staines. The covering letter requests that serious consideration is taken of the residents' wishes and the proposals are rejected.

BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY

At the meeting on 02 July 2007 this Committee resolved that residents and businesses in the proposed area of Staines, as displayed at that meeting, are consulted informally on the introduction of Controlled Parking, comprising eight zones, prior to formal consultation being carried out by Public Notice.

The outcome of the informal consultation with residents and businesses will be reported back to the March 2008 meeting of this Committee. This petition will be considered as part of the response to the consultation.
