- 43/09 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST (ITEM 2)**

- 44/09 PROPOSED RESIDENTS PERMIT SCHEMES IN GEORGE STREET, LAMMAS CLOSE AND MOORMEDE ESTATE (ITEM 3)**
Following a discussion regarding earlier consultation with residents about the costs of parking permits, the committee felt that the proposed charge of £50 for a residents permit was too high. Cllr Forsbrey proposed an amendment to recommendation iv to reflect this view, which was seconded by Mrs Saliagopoulos.
Resolved:
(i) that the proposed residents permit schemes for George Street, Lammas Close and the Moormede Estate be

- formally advertised in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)
- (ii) that, subject to no objection being received in response to the advertisement, the schemes be implemented
 - (iii) that where any objections are received which cannot be resolved by the Parking Projects Manager, they be referred back to the Local Committee for Decision
 - (iv) that the permit criteria, eligibility and allocation be agreed as set out in this report, but that the charge for a residents permit be set at £30 per annum and the visitors permit at £1 each.
