



OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (SPELTHORNE)

PETITION – BROADLANDS AVENUE, SHEPPERTON

KEY ISSUE:

To advise the Committee that a petition has been received from Mr Mike Claydon, which is signed by 38 residents of Broadlands Avenue.

SUMMARY:

The petition states:

“We, the undersigned, request that the county council consider the implementation of some sort of controlled or restricted parking and any other traffic management scheme which will solve the congestion and parking issue in respect of residents and users of Broadlands Avenue.

We ask that the council work jointly with residents to produce a plan of proposals for implementation, and that appropriate funding will be found”.
