

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE

(Spelthorne)

PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR BURGES WAY, STAINES AND CLARENDON ROAD, ASHFORD 19th March 2012

KEY ISSUES

To approve arrangements for progressing Traffic Regulation Orders for proposed amendments to on-street parking restrictions in the Spelthorne borough.

SUMMARY

Burges Way, Staines

Visitors to the Staines Health Centre are finding it increasingly difficult to park nearby due to all day parking by commuters. It is therefore proposed to introduce parking bays in Burges Way with a 3 hour maximum waiting period as shown on **Annex A** to prevent commuter parking whilst allowing sufficient time for visitors. This proposal includes some sections of double yellow lines to prevent obstructive parking outside of the parking bays and making the two existing advisory disabled parking bays enforceable.

Clarendon Road, Ashford

The current parking restriction (no waiting Monday to Saturday 7am to 7pm) outside St Michael's Catholic Church currently prevents visitors to the church attending service (Mass) on Saturday evenings. It is therefore proposed to change the existing restriction to 'no waiting Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 5.00pm' as shown on **Annex B.**

OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

The Local Committee (Spelthorne) is asked to agree:

- That the proposed amendments to on-street parking restrictions in (i) Spelthorne as described in this report and shown in detail on drawings presented at this committee meeting as annex A and B are agreed.
- (ii) That the intention of the County Council to make an Order under the relevant parts of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to impose the waiting and on street parking restrictions in Spelthorne as shown on the drawings in annex A and B be advertised and that if no objections be maintained, the Orders be made.
