Spelthorne 2012/13 Workshop note

Overview of funds available:

Local Revenue: £215,800 (£115,800 increase on 2011/12)

• Community Pride: £35,000 (Same as 2011/12)

• Capital Integrated Transport Schemes: £140,272 (Same as 2011/12)

 Capital Maintenance: £140,272 (New funding stream for Committees in 2012/13)

Local Revenue

It is proposed that as in 2011/12 a portion of the revenue budget is top sliced for Boroughwide issues managed by Officers through delegated authority such as **Ditching & Drainage, Vegetation and Parking.** In addition to this Members are asked to consider a creating a budget for **illuminated street furniture** renewal which are not part of the Countywide streetlighting contract, the focus would be on reviewing use and if applicable replacing old equipment with new LED equipment which have lower energy costs.

In addition to the above it is proposed that a fund is created to tackle 'Local Issues' which would not rate high enough for intervention from Countywide budgets. This would provide a similar facility to the Minor Schemes budget from 2011/12 but it would be increased by £55,000 and have greater flexibility of spend to respond to issues raised locally be it from Members, partners or other stakeholders such as the Police. Officers would not recommend rigidly splitting funding equally amongst divisions instead through careful management an evenness of spread could be ensured and this could be tracked throughout the year via reporting to either informal or formal committees. In essence the Local Issues fund would provide additional flexibility for both Officers and Members beyond the funds available from Community Pride. If Members chose to reject Officer advice and split equally amongst divisions they would be strongly advised to have a cut off point at which point if funding had not been allocated it should be spent elsewhere in the Borough.

Community Pride

It is proposed that this is split equally amongst County Members as in 2011/12. However, members would be advised that they should set a cut off fund for bids, at which point the money could be added to the Local Issues fund.

Capital Integrated Transport Schemes Programme

Further to confirmation that funding levels will remain at 2011/12 levels it is proposed that Members agree a list of schemes to take forward in 2012/13. The emphasis of the programme being on those of strategic worth whilst minor local schemes are funded from the Local Issues budget or Community Pride eg a new sign or hanging baskets. Please note that any schemes approved from the 2011/12 Programme which are yet to be completed/invoiced will be carried forward including the funding. Schemes which Members may wish to consider in 2012/13 include:

Capital Maintenance

Further to the confirmation of a new funding stream being created to target capital maintenance in the Borough (£140,272), Members are asked to consider how this could be allocated, options include undertaking one or two larger maintenance schemes or a number of local schemes (Local Structural Repair and Footway Improvements)

Option 1: Appendix 1 contains a list of roads which did not score quite highly enough to warrant treatment with the budgets available at a county level. If Members wished to progress with one or two bigger schemes they would be advised to consider those from this list. Although it cannot be guaranteed it should be noted that there would be a good chance that these locations would rise up the list in the following year when list is reviewed.

The Area Team would advise that in order to spread maximum benefit of funding across the Borough this budget could be directed at a greater number of smaller Local Structural Repair schemes and footway schemes see Option 2.

Option 2 (Preferred): Appendix 2 provides a list of locations which Members may wish to consider requesting costings for Local Structural Repair. In all instances Officers will first look for funding from Countywide repair budgets before utilising Committee budgets. If there are other similar locations Members wish to see costed they are asked to submit details ASAP. Please note it is highly unlikely that all those on this list could be funded with the budgets available and Members would therefore be advised by Officers which schemes should be progressed if they wish to follow this option.
