- a. <u>Bridleway No. 107</u> (Chobham) from point 'A' in a north easterly direction for 110 metres to point 'C', as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/81/H53.

Description of site of new path or way

- a. <u>Bridleway No. 107</u> (Chobham) from point 'A' in a north easterly direction for 120 metres to point 'B', as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/81/H53. The bridleway to have a minimum width of 4.0 metres throughout.
- b. <u>Bridleway No. 111</u> (Chobham) from point 'B' in a south easterly direction for 234 metres to point 'D', as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/81/H53a. The bridleway to have a minimum width of 4.0 metres throughout.






