# PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL FOOTPATH NO. 113 (CHOBHAM) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2004

This Order is made by the County Council of Surrey ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order and the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted;

Mr Colin Woodbridge of Burnside Nursery, Philpot Lane, Chobham and Mrs A Parker of Sunfield Farm, Philpot Lane, Chobham have agreed to contribute towards any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new-site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public:

The Surrey Heath Borough Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

## BY THIS ORDER:-

1 THE public right of way over the land situate at Burnside Nursery and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

<u>2 THERE</u> shall at the end of 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Burnside Nursery as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

3 THE rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

### Part 1

Description of site of existing path or way

Footpath No. 113 (Chobham) from point 'A' in a south easterly direction to point 'B' then continuing to point 'C', a total distance of 564 metres, as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/81/H51.

### Part 2

# Description of site of new path or way

Footpath No. 113 (Chobham) from point 'D' in a north easterly direction to point 'E', continuing in a more south easterly direction to point 'C', a total distance of 600 metres, as shown on Drawing No. 3/1/81/H51. The footpath to have a minimum width of 2.0 metres throughout.


