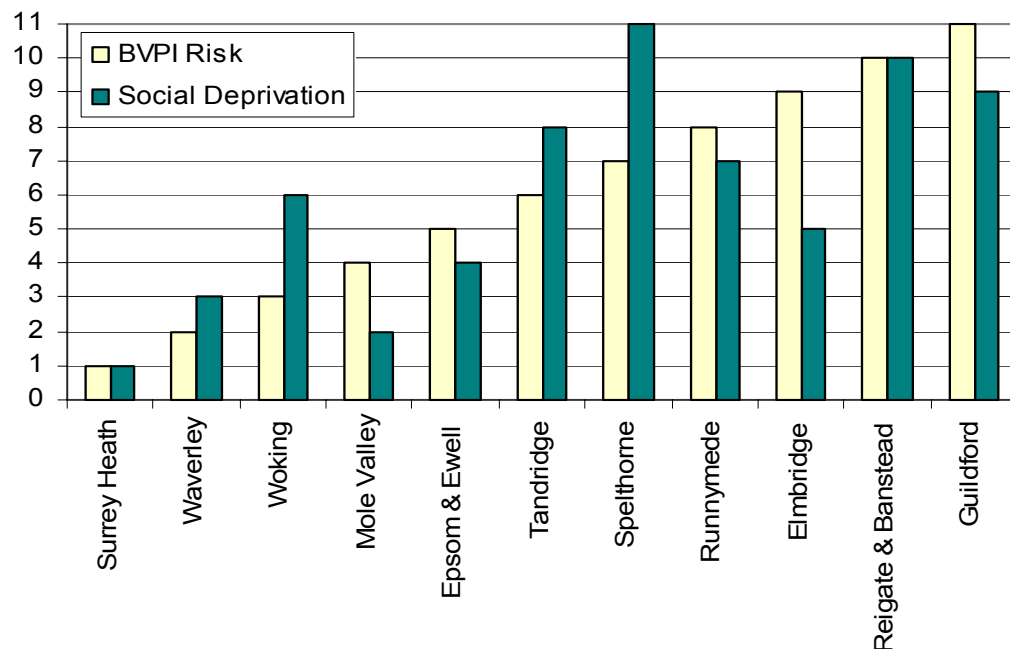

The graph below shows the BVPI risk ranking and social deprivation ranking for each borough, in order of the BVPI risk, where 1 is the lowest BVPI risk ranking.

The table below highlights the difference between the level of social deprivation and BVPI risk. A negative score indicates a higher level of activity than would be expected in relation to the boroughs social deprivation ranking.



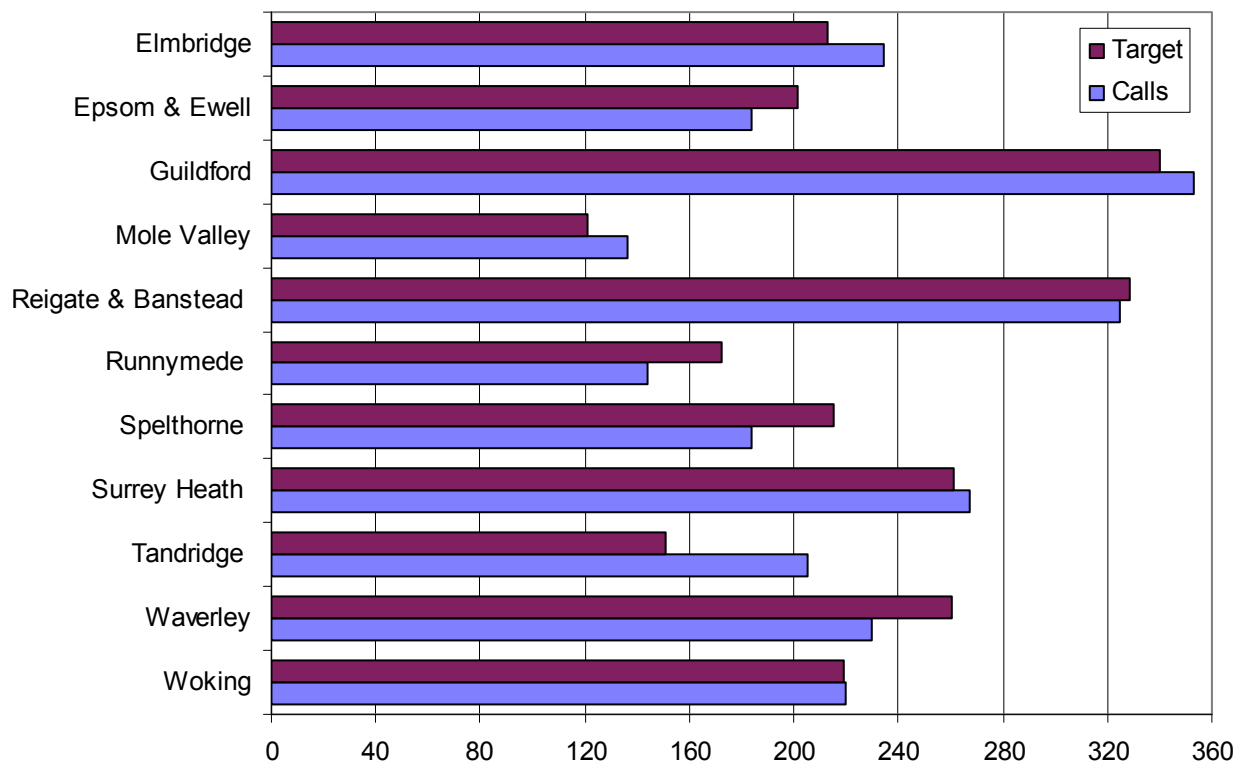

All boroughs within Surrey experience low levels of social deprivation, falling within the top quartile of all local authorities within England and Wales (source: ONS). Of the 11 boroughs Spelthorne has the highest level of social deprivation. Reigate and Banstead has the second highest level of the 11 boroughs. Surrey Heath has the lowest level of social deprivation out of the 11 boroughs.

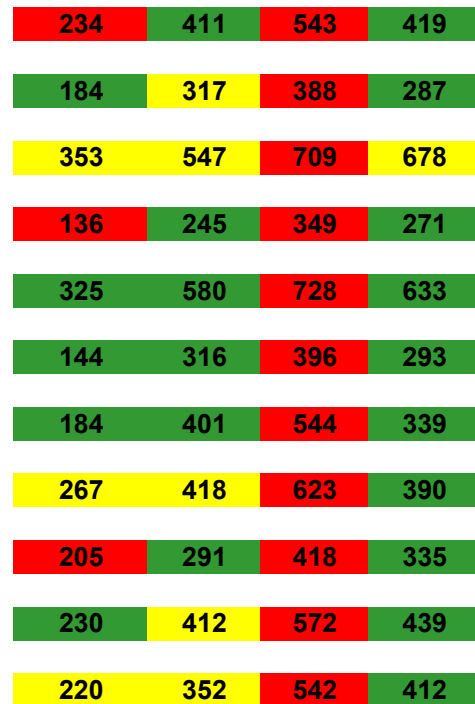

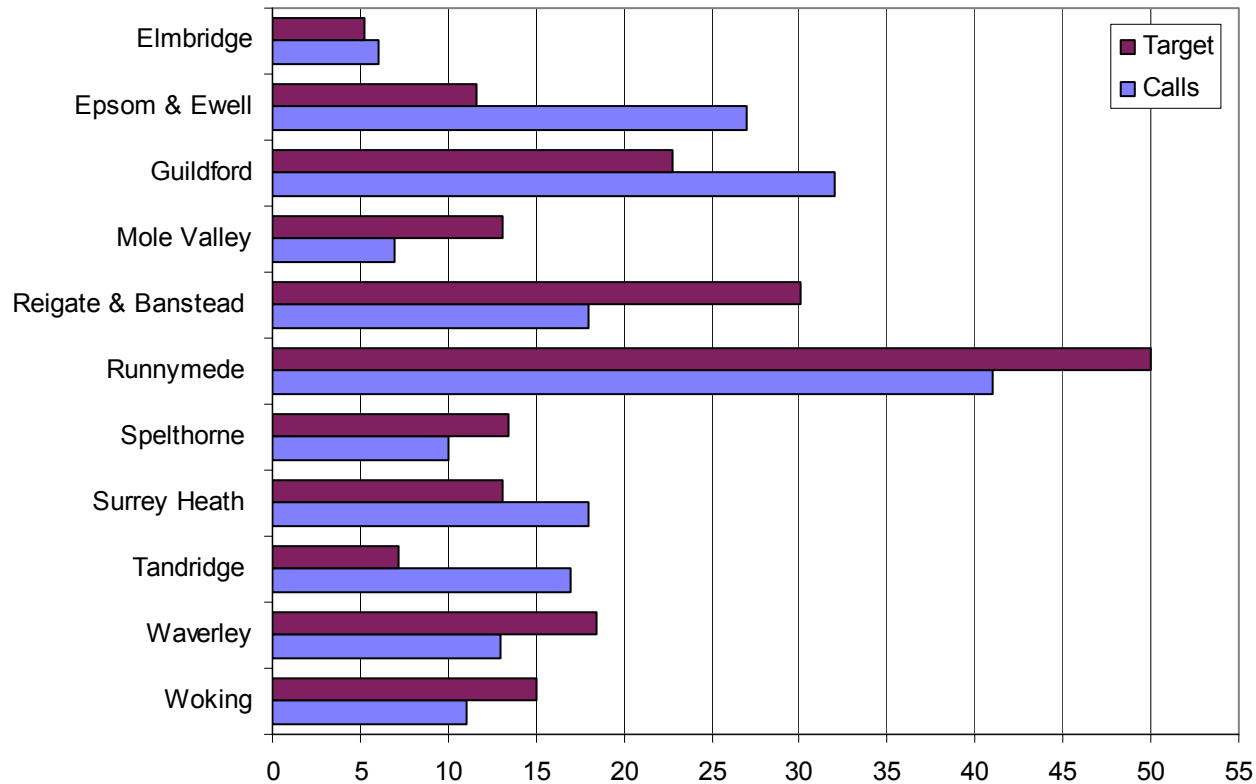

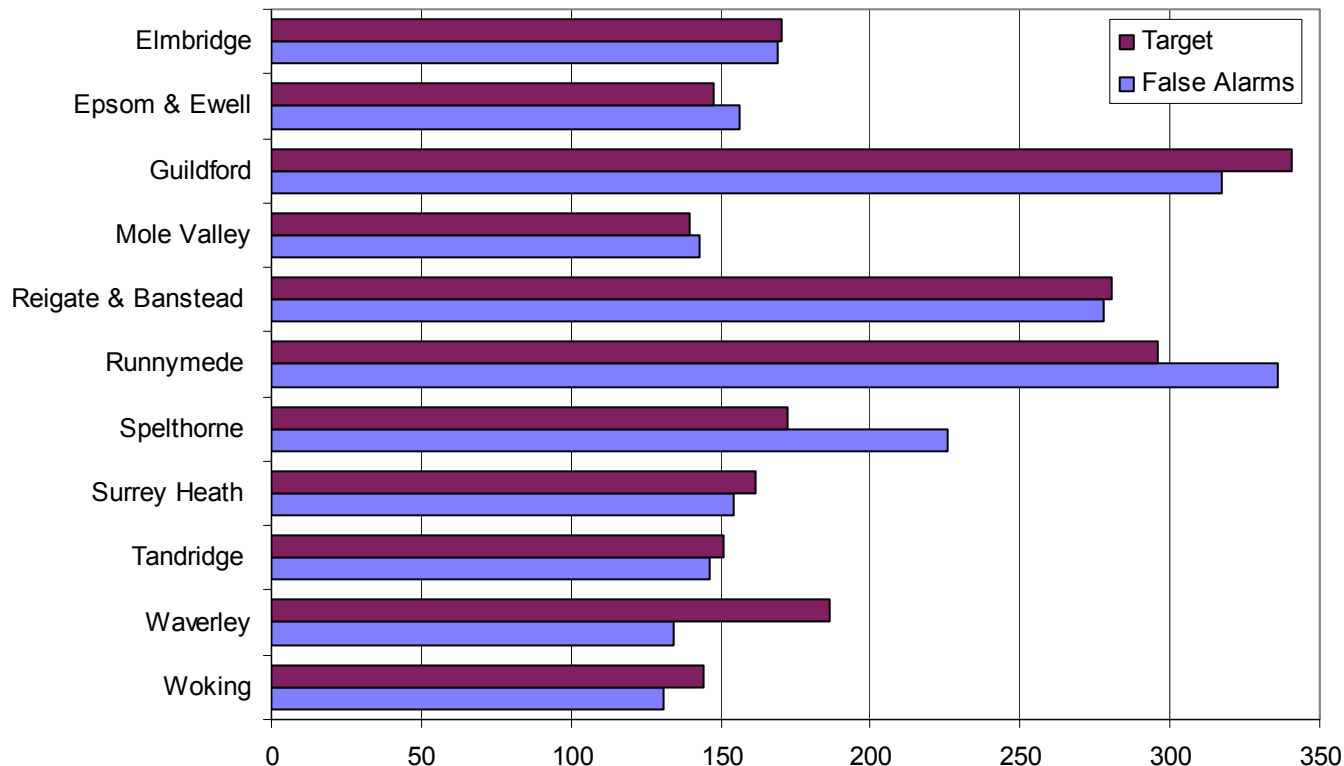

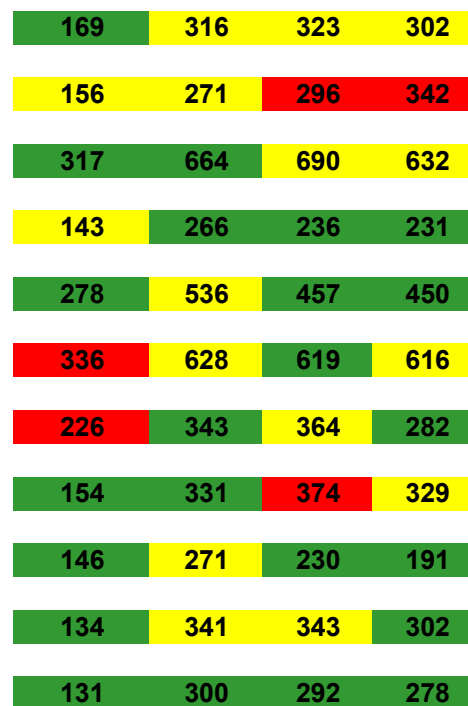

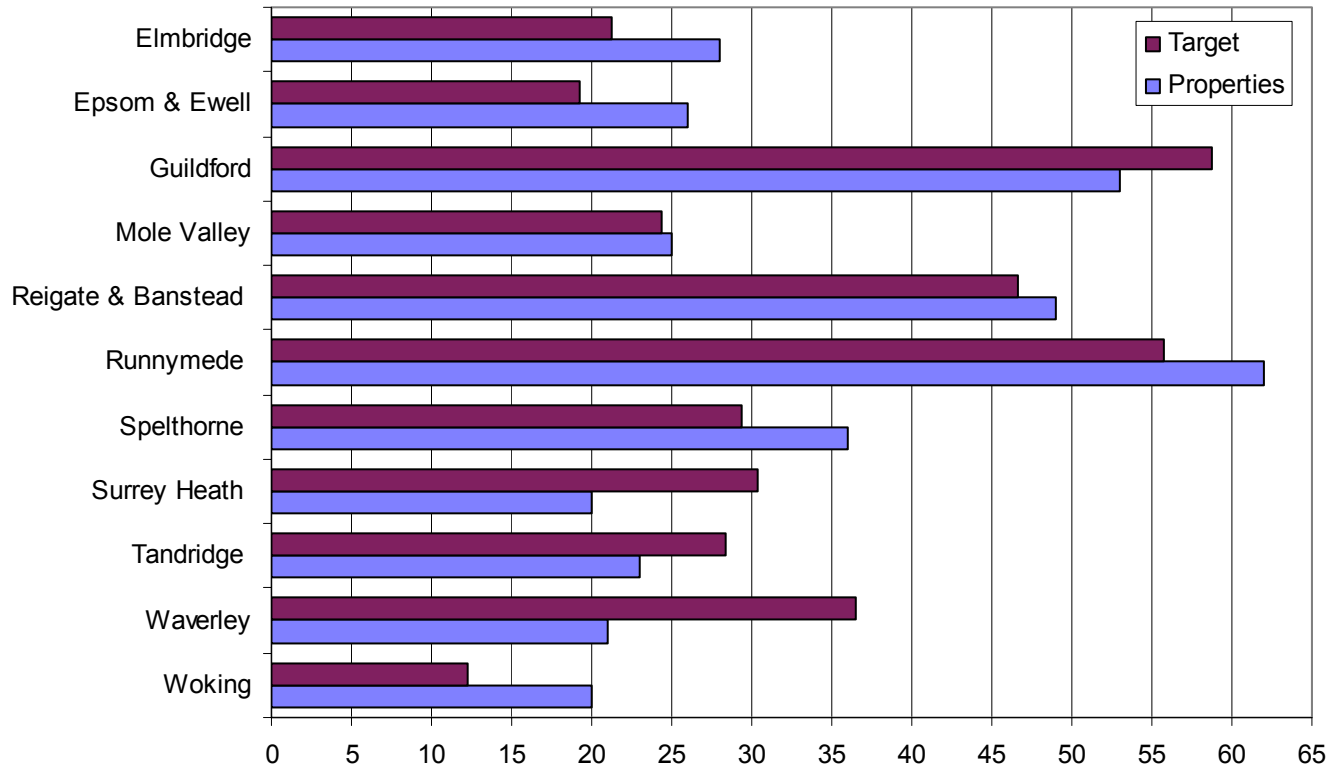

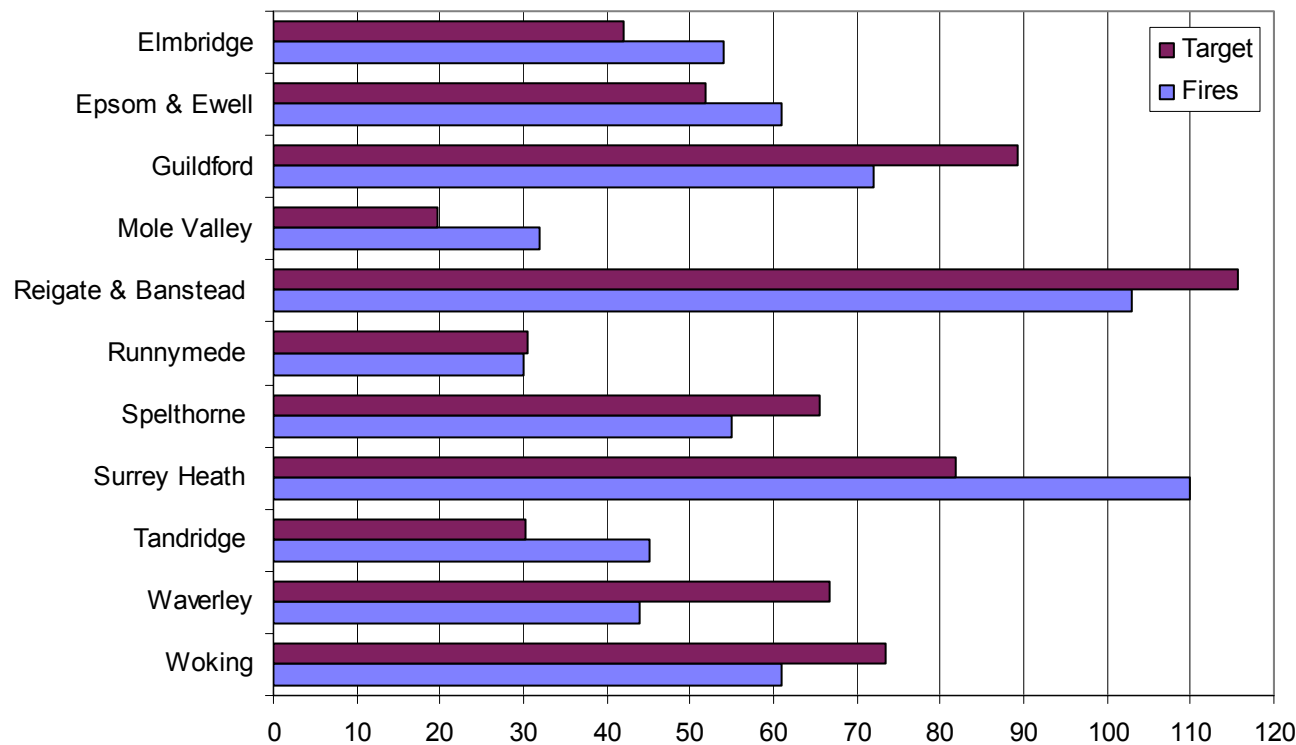

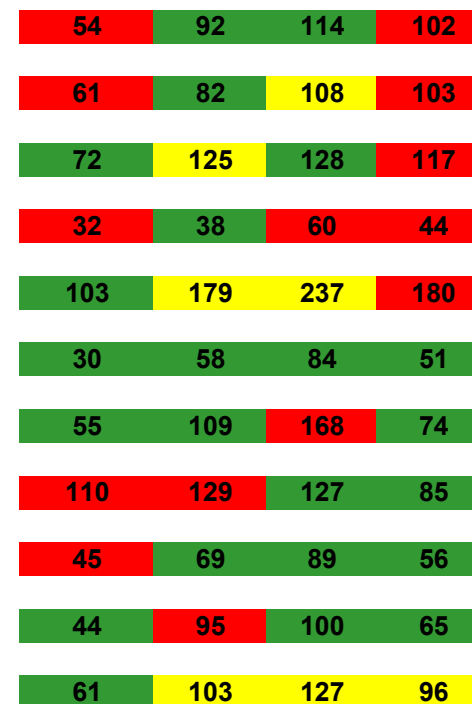

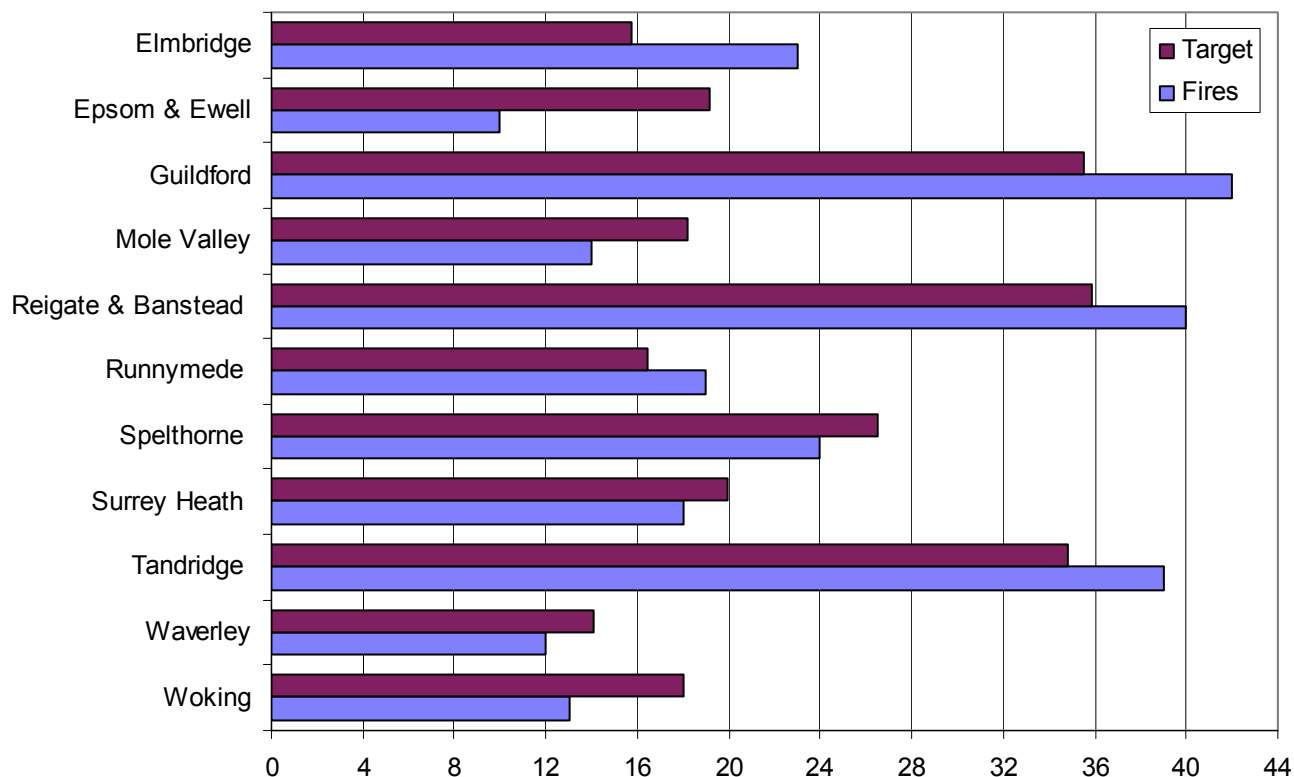
