Flooding

The recent heavy rain has not resulted in significant flooding incidents within Surrey Heath. Surrey County Council is continuing to work with partners to ensure that the local area is protected as far as possible from future incidents eg SCC officers have developed strong links with the Surrey Heath Borough Council's Land Drainage Engineer and discuss local issues several times a week. A strategy to ensure that ditches are kept serviceable is also being worked on. The programme of gully maintenance has been progressing through Surrey Heath in recent weeks.

Frimley Green Youth Centre

Following discussions with members of the community and a wide range of service providers and the voluntary sector, it has been decided to keep Frimley Green Youth Centre open. The Centre will offer an increased number of opportunities for young people and will work in partnership with others, including Surrey Connexions, Waverley Training, Surrey Police and Surrey Heath Borough Council.

The programme will include two evenings of 'open access' sessions as well as a number of more targeted projects throughout the week. In addition there will be an increase in daytime provision offering accredited learning opportunities for young parents, targeted work supporting young people at risk of, or involved in, antisocial behaviour and after school sessions offering information, advice and guidance to young people. Club Shout, the Lorraine Day School of Dance and other existing community use will not be affected
