Re: Objection to double Yellow Lines in Southern Road

For 52 years we have enjoyed the use of a footpath along the front of our property, which you have removed and replaced with Yellow Lines along the boundary line.

We were promised reserved parking for Southern road residents which it seems you have decided is no longer possible.

This and the previous point make it very difficult for family and friends to visit as often as they used to, it is particularly difficult for elderly visitors.

I would suggest a solution might be to utilise the areas opposite houses 10-20 in a way as to increase the number of parking spaces significantly.

If these were used to park cars side by side (as opposed to end to end) there would be enough room for 25 vehicles.

This number of allocated parking spaces would help a lot to solve the parking problems for residents.
