Bus Review

Phase 2 of the Surrey County Council bus review will look at buses in Surrey Heath, the western part of Woking and Tandridge. Consultation on possible changes to the services that are subsidised by the County Council will begin in September 2011. Any changes will start late August 2012 to coincide with the new school year.

As part of the wider Bus Review, the County Council is currently consulting schools and parents about the School Special services' future (public buses that serve particular secondary schools). Recommendations were made to cabinet on 13 July 2010, and any changes to services will take place from summer 2011. All current services will run during the 2010/11 school year. Farnborough Airport

The public inquiry into the appeal by TAG Farnborough Airport against the Council's decision to refuse planning permission for the proposal to increase business aviation movements, has now ended. The six-week inquiry was held at the Council Offices, Farnborough from May 26 to June 30 and was heard by the appointed inspectors Mr. David Richards and Mr. Lloyd Rogers. The inspectors will now prepare a report to the Secretaries of State for Communities and Local Government and for Transport, who will make the final decision on whether planning permission is granted or not. The date of this decision is not yet known, but it is anticipated to be some time towards the end of the year. For more information go to www.rushmoor.gov.uk

Flooding

The Surrey County Council Environment and Economy Select Committee is now due to re-examine the Pitt Review in September 2010. The Safer and Stronger Select Committee will also be invited to attend this meeting. Local Chobham residents are working in partnership with Surrey County Council, Councillor Sealy, Surrey Heath Borough Council, Surrey Fire and Rescue, Surrey Police and the Environment Agency through the Chobham Community Resilience Action Group (CRAG) to help ensure the local community are able to respond effectively when there is the risk of flooding. The group is jointly chaired by Councillor Sealy and Surrey Fire and Rescue.

A Chobham Community Emergency Plan is being developed by the group, which outlines how the local community will respond in the event of a flood. It contains information on the role of the local flood warden volunteers including how they alert vulnerable members of the local community, access local stores of sandbags and skills and resources. Another initiative which has been agreed by the group is the use of flooding advisory road signs to limit the impact of road flooding. Once the flood advisory road signs are fully developed by the group and signed off by Surrey CC Highways, the local community flood wardens will be able to quickly display them when road flooding occurs.
