**RESPONSE TO PETITION -  
REDUCING THE RED ROAD SPEED LIMIT TO 40MPH  
30 June 2011**

**KEY ISSUE**

To respond to the petition received by Local Committee on 17 February 2011.

**SUMMARY**

**Wording of Petition**

“We, the undersigned, urgently request Surrey County Councillor Ian Lake to review the speed limit on the whole of the Red Road and for it to be reduced to 40mph. This being from The Maultway roundabout, Camberley, to the Gordon’s School roundabout, West End. Since 2002 there have tragically been 6 fatalities and 14 hospital admissions on this now extremely busy road.”

The petition was signed by over 400 Surrey residents.

**Officer response**

As requested, this matter has been presented to Ian Lake, Cabinet Member for Environment and Infrastructure, who has instructed that this matter be decided upon by the Local Committee.

The issue of the Red Road speed limit is one that has been considered previously by Committee, and for this reason, a separate report on this matter has been presented as Item 20, for decision.
