



Item 5 – Written Public Question

Q. Written Question from Mr. David Chesneau, Chair of The Camberley Society, in connection with the junction of the High Street and Portesbery Road/Pembroke Broadway, Camberley town centre.

What further steps will the county council take to improve road safety for pedestrians crossing Portesbery Road in Camberley near its junction with the High Street? There has been no apparent change since the society drew the attention of the Local Committee to this issue on 16th February.'

Response from Chairman on behalf of the Committee:

Further to the response given to the previous public question considered by the Local Committee at its meeting on the 16th February 2012, Surrey County Council (SCC) wrote to the developer asking them to reposition the hoarding to improve visibility for pedestrians crossing Portesbery Road. Unfortunately, no response has been received. Surrey County Council has therefore now contacted the agent that acted in respect of the planning application. If this does not result in the requested realignment of the hoarding then the issue will be referred to SCC Legal Services to pursue.
