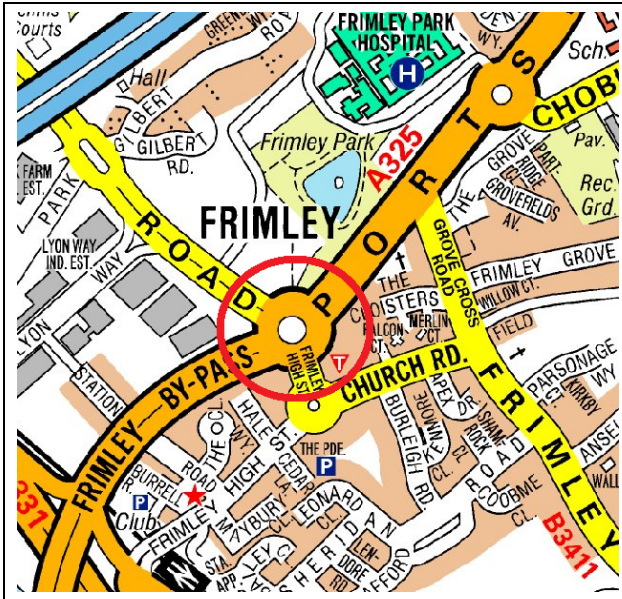


**SCHEME CARD**

**A325/B3411 ROUNDABOUT, FRIMLEY**

**Site details:**

The roundabout is a major link between Frimley, Camberley and Farnborough and forms a major link to the A331 and subsequently the M3. The junction is also within close vicinity of Frimley town, a business park, a number of schools, and Frimley Park Hospital. As such, there is a considerable amount of traffic using the junction for much of the day.

**Need for measures:**

For large parts of the day the roundabout suffers from severe congestion that causes delays for motorists and affects air quality.

The following are some of the factors that contribute to the problem:- close vicinity of Frimley, a business park, two schools, and Frimley Park Hospital. The roundabout also acts as access to the A331 and, indirectly, to the M3.

The roundabout has an ongoing problem with personal injury accidents occurring (see accident data below).

With close access to Frimley, improvements to the pedestrian and cycle access would increase sustainable travel for those living in the area.

**Proposed Measures:**

Install traffic signal control on all arms of the roundabout to improve road safety and allow better flow of vehicles and pedestrian/cycle traffic around the junction and the surrounding area.

**Estimated Cost:**

A budget of approximately £600,000 would be required to undertake the design and construction.

Significant developer funding is available to contribute towards the costs of the scheme.
