

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE TANDRIDGE

MINOR CHANGES TO FOOTWAYS TO IMPROVE ACCESSIBILITY

5 OCTOBER 2007

KEY ISSUE

Programme of footway improvements using the £15,000 allocation for Accessibility in Tandridge.

SUMMARY

Requests are received for footway improvements such as dropped kerbs to facilitate wheelchair access. The Local Committee on 22 June 2007 approved a £15,000 allocation for Accessibility from the Local Transport Plan 2007-08 budget for Integrated Transport in Tandridge. This report proposes a schedule of footway improvements.

OFFICER RECOMMENDATIONS

The Local Committee for Tandridge is asked to agree that:

The schedule of footway improvements listed in Annex A be progressed.

1 INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Local Committee on 22nd June 2007 approved an allocation of £15,000 for Accessibility. This allocation is part of the 2007-08 budget for Local Transport Plan funded Integrated Transport in Tandridge.
- 1.2 Requests for accessibility improvements on the highways within Tandridge have been received over the last few years. Most of the requests are for dropped kerbs and associated improvements to facilitate road crossing.

2 ANALYSIS

- 2.1 Dropped kerbs are essential in some places to allow access by wheelchairs, mobility scooters, prams and push chairs. They also act to formalise a road crossing point and encourage pedestrians to cross roads at designated places.
- 2.2 Tactile paving is invariably installed in association with dropped kerbs. The tactile paving serves to facilitate use of road crossing points by visually impaired people.

3 OPTIONS

- 3.1 A list of locations proposed for footway improvements is shown at Annex 1. The list is split into Phase 1, Phase 2 and Wish list. The £15,000 available funding should be sufficient to complete all the Phase 1 proposals and some of the Phase 2 proposals.
- 3.2 The wish list can be maintained and updated for progression of improvements in future years.

4 CONSULTATIONS

- 4.1 The Tandridge Access Group has agreed the Phase 1 and 2 locations shown in Annex 1.
- 4.2 The Chairman and Vice-Chairman have been provided with a draft copy of this report.

5 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS AND VALUE FOR MONEY

5.1 The £15,000 sum for Accessibility is an allocation from the Local Transport Plan budget for Integrated Transport in Tandridge. Dropped kerbs provide important accessibility improvements valued by members of the community.
