ROLE OF ORGANISATION OR GROUP

To provide opportunities for Young people(13-19) to develop personal and social skills that enhance their life skills and life choices. By working with targeted young people in a range of settings who are perceived as more at risk.

RECENT SUCCESSES

- Impact project has completed a 1 year pilot and is due to develop into a full day accredited project in October – Referrals from CIAG. Coworked with Police Personnel
- Summer Jams attracted 200+ Young people and involved Key Young People from their communities which contributed to a reduction in anti social incidents around the skate parks in Tandridge
- Caterham Youth Bus has recorded 400+ contacts and has ensured that information is shared and staff have explained the use of dispersal orders when in force.
- A Pilot project was run for Tandridge Young people who were excluded from school to provide Personal and Social skills required to return to Mainstream Education.
- Young People at Risk of exclusion from Warlingham School were able to attain accreditation and engage in an alternative curriculum to equip them with greater skills post-16 and to enhance their school experience

ASPIRATIONS FOR THE FUTURE

- To involve Young people From Caterham on the Hill in a Community Safety Audit.
- To Offer two 2-week activity-based programmes to targeted Young People
- To set Princes Trust XL programme in Warlingham School for Young People at Risk of Exclusion
- To re establish work with the Pupil Referral Unit to provide a programme for young people excluded from school and not in any provision.
- To establish a dedicated Youth space in Caterham
- To open Harry's Youth Centre 3 evenings a week.
