Surrey County Council will be carrying out essential maintenance works, including drain cleaning and minor pothole repairs, in these roads on the night of the 27th and the day of the 28th October 2008.

To help us carry out the works, **please can you ensure that you do not leave any vehicle in these roads** between 9pm Monday 27th to 5pm Tuesday 28th October. Extra parking spaces are being made available, but please remember to display this letter in your windscreen if you use:

- Top floor of Morrisons' car park.
- Premises in Croydon Road/Farningham Road (previously a Family Services Centre).
- Premises in Croydon Road/Farningham Road (previously an Adult Education Centre).

We want to improve the highway drainage around the town centre and your cooperation would be appreciated by everyone concerned. Access will be restricted and on-street parking will not be permitted. If you can foresee difficulties please contact telephone number 08456 009009. For instance, if we know of any parking requirements for car blue badge holders, we will try to make special arrangements.

Why is the work being done? To improve highway safety in Caterham Valley.

How long will the work take? I night and 1 day only.
