

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE (TANDRIDGE)

HIGHWAY SCHEMES IN TANDRIDGE PROGRESS REPORT 5 DECEMBER 2008

KEY ISSUE

To update the Local Committee on the progress of schemes being funding in the 2008/09 financial year.

SUMMARY

On 20 June 2008, the Local Committee noted the East Area Maintenance Delivery Plan and agreed a list of integrated transport schemes for the current financial year, funded from the Local Transport Plan and Local Allocation budgets. On 5 September 2008, the Local Committee endorsed extra funding for highway maintenance and schemes in Tandridge. This report sets out progress on highway schemes and other highway works for Tandridge. The Local Committee Chairman has reviewed the information available with officers so that any provided forecast dates are the best available at the time of writing.

OTHER MAINTENANCE WORKS

Routine maintenance works are continuing in accordance with the East Area Maintenance Delivery Plan. Some additional works were agreed by the Local Committee on 5 September 2008.

DRAINAGE CLEANSING. The following locations have been targeted for additional cleansing: Westmore Road, Tatsfield soakaways, manholes/catchpits and pipes cleansed, but further works required -Tupwood Lane, Caterham soakaway work complete Outwood Lane, Outwood system cleanse near Browns Hill complete -Farleigh Court Road, Warlingham system cleansing complete -Slines Oak Road, Woldingham cleansing two soakaways complete cleansing soakaway, gully and pipe complete Ship Hill, Tatsfield -Farleigh Road, Warlingham soakaway cleansing complete -Tilburstow Hill Rd, Sth Godstone cleansing carried out, repairs required -DRAINAGE REPAIRS. The following schemes are being progressed. Harrow Road, Chelsham repair or replace drain under speed table. Snatts Hill, Oxted works started to replace approximately 175 metres drain and provide two inspection chambers. Beadles Lane, Oxted completed repair of gully and replacement of approx 40 metres drain. Johnsdale, Oxted drainage repair required. Outwood Lane, Outwood excavate 50 metres culvert to create ditch. Oxted Road, Tandridge drainage repair required -Woodhurst Lane, Oxted drainage repair required -Tilburstow Hill Rd, Sth Godstone drainage repair required
