

OFFICER REPORT TO LOCAL COMMITTEE TANDRIDGE

HIGHWAY SCHEMES IN TANDRIDGE

PROGRESS REPORT

6 MARCH 2009

KEY ISSUE

To update the Local Committee on the progress of schemes being funding in the 2008/09 financial year.

SUMMARY

On 20 June 2008, the Local Committee noted the East Area Maintenance Delivery Plan and agreed a list of integrated transport schemes for the current financial year, funded from the Local Transport Plan and Local Allocation budgets. On 5 September 2008, the Local Committee endorsed extra funding for highway maintenance and schemes in Tandridge. This report sets out progress on highway schemes and other highway works for Tandridge.

Use of Tandridge allocations from additional £5million for highways

A report to the Local Committee on 5 September 2008 provided information about the allocations for Tandridge from an additional £5 million for highways in Surrey during the current financial year. These funds were agreed by the Executive on 24 June 2008. The Head of Surrey Highways and the Executive Portfolio Holder for Transport then met with the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Local Highways Manager to draw together a preferred list of works and schemes for Tandridge. Details of the work progressed is included in the preceding tables, but the following gives a brief summary.

Patching £65,000. This funding is additional to the £103,000 of Local Schemes Revenue funding also used for patching work. 14 sites in the programme of 18 have been completed.

Carriageway edge repairs £70,000. The most severe problems of carriageway edge erosion in Tandridge Lane and Ricketts Hill Road are to be remedied. The works are planned for late February and early March.

Gully and drainage cleansing. £50,000. A combined gully cleanser and long powerful jetter has been provided as a responsive facility for the many drainage problem locations. A targeted gully and drainage cleansing operation was successfully carried out in the vicinity of Caterham Valley town centre.

Drainage repairs. £30,000. A number of locations have benefited from minor works on broken pipes, tree roots, defective gully gratings and similar defects. 5 of the 8 priority sites have been completed.

Hedge, tree and grass cutting £60,000. A programme of flail mowing and hand cutting has been completed except for 4 flailing sites.

Parking restrictions. £62,000. The set of new restrictions approved by the Local Committee in June 2007 have mostly been implemented. Another set of sites requiring investigation has been prepared for consultation with members.

Speed limit revisions. £30,000. Planned work on two identified priority sites is programmed for completion by the end of the current financial year.
